RENTER shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Manatee County from any and all third-party claims, liabilities, loss or cause of action for property damage or bodily injury, including death, arising out of any act or omission of the RENTER or any defect in the property or its improvements arising out of or in connection with its activities, use, and occupation of the Property under this Agreement. Such indemnification shall include, but not be limited to, the payment of all claims, losses, and judgments of any nature whatsoever in connection therewith, and the payment of all related fees and costs, including any attorney's fees incurred by the County in connection with the RENTER's activities arising out of the performance of this Agreement.

I acknowledge that by renting this pavilion, additional fees, a special event permit and/or certificate of insurance may be required to utilize equipment such as a DJ, live band, air structure, such as a bounce house, or display or structure that is special or unique in nature. I understand that the pavilion rental fee is non-refundable and have received a copy of the Pavilion Information Sheet.

Guidelines

Bounce houses are permitted at certain pavilions and require an additional PERMIT fee and certificate of insurance.

Park gates will not be unlocked for closer access to the pavilion.

Pavilion rental fees are non-refundable. In the event a pavilion reservation is cancelled by the customer (minimum of 2 weeks prior to the rental date), a credit may be requested and can be used toward another rental, program or activity within one year from the original request.

ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED IN ANY COUNTY PARK FACILITY.

WATER SLIDES ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY COUNTY PARK/PAVILION.

USE OF CONFETTI IS NOT PERMITTED, INCLUDING FOR GENDER REVEAL PARTIES.

Day of the Rental

1. Take your pavilion reservation receipt with you.
2. If someone is using the pavilion that you have reserved, present the copy of your receipt to the people using the pavilion. If they do not leave the pavilion, you may contact the Manatee County Sheriff's Office non-emergency number at 747-3011. For G.T. Bray Park and East Bradenton Park rentals, please contact the Bradenton Police Department's non-emergency number at 932-9300. For Coquina Beach Park and Anna Maria Bayfront Park rentals, please contact the Bradenton Beach Police Department's non-emergency number at 778-6311.
3. If your reserved pavilion has not been cleaned or is damaged, please call 742-5841 to reach an on-call parks maintenance staff member for assistance.

General Information

1. A pavilion reservation only reserves the actual pavilion. All playgrounds, restrooms and open space surrounding the pavilion are open for the public to use. Any additional tents, tables, etc. are prohibited without a special event permit. Water spigots are not available.
- Stapling any type of papers, decorations, or information onto the pavilion or picnic tables is prohibited. No confetti permitted including use for gender reveal parties. All gates are locked for safety reasons. Maintenance will not unlock them. All cars must park in the parking lot.
