1. To complete the rental process, you may reserve and pay for a pavilion online at www.mymanatee.org/parks or visit the G.T. Bray Recreation Center.
2. Rental fees are non-refundable. In the event a reservation is cancelled by the customer (minimum of 2 weeks prior to the rental date), a credit may be requested and can be used toward another rental, program or activity within ninety (90) days from the original request.

Day of the Rental

1. Take your reservation receipt with you.
2. A Ranger will meet you at your rental sight, if prearranged.

General Information

1. A pavilion reservation only reserves the actual pavilion. All restrooms and open space surrounding the pavilion are open for the public to use.
2. Stapling any type of papers, decorations or information onto the pavilion or picnic tables is prohibited.
3. Balloons, piñatas, and amplified music are prohibited.
4. Open fires and use of citronella candles/tiki torches are prohibited.
5. Except for trash placed in receptacles, everything brought in for this event must be removed when you vacate the preserve.
6. **ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED IN ANY COUNTY FACILITY**
7. Generators are not permitted.
8. Inflatables are not permitted.
