Garbage will be collected twice per week.

Recycling and yard waste will be collected once per week on your

SAME SERVICE DAYS

What to do with your OLD BLUE BINS:

- 1) Keep them! Use it to collect recyclables in your home!
- 2) Let us recycle them! Put your empty blue bins at the curb on your upcoming recycling service day. Or, drop them off at the Lena Road Landfill (3333 Lena Road) or the County Utilities building (4410 66th Street West).

If you are hesitant about using your new recycling cart, the County recycling department asks you to use it over the next 90 days while the collection haulers ensure all residents in the unincorporated portion of the County have received their cart. Introducing a Better Way to Recycle: **Single Stream Recycling!**

Recycle All Together –
Recycle Right!

What is Single Stream Recycling?

Single stream recycling refers to the “all-in-one” collection of all clean recyclable paper and mixed containers together in the blue cart, eliminating the need for sorting. *It's easy and convenient.* Once collected, all materials are separated for re-use at a materials recycling facility.

What are the Benefits of the New Single Stream Recycling Program?

- ✓ No more sorting! All recyclables now go into the new blue cart.
- ✓ Fewer trips to the curb. No more taking out multiple bins.
- ✓ Less litter in our neighborhoods. Materials are in a closed cart rather than open bins.
- ✓ Higher participation and recovery rates due to convenience and simplicity.

What Materials Can I Recycle in the Blue Cart?

The following materials should be placed loosely in the cart and not bagged:

All Paper – if it's clean and unsoiled, put it into the cart!

- Mail, Magazines, Newspapers and Inserts
- Food Boxes (i.e. cereal)
- Writing Papers, Pads and Notes
- Cardboard Boxes (flattened)
- Paper Bags



Containers – food and beverage containers as described below:

- Aluminum Cans and Unsoiled Foil
- Tin, Steel and Aerosol Cans
- Glass Jars and Bottles (all colors)
- All Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Containers



- Gable Top Cartons (milk and juice boxes)

Keep Recycling Carts Clean and free of garbage.

These are some of the items that will cause the cart not to be emptied:

- Garbage
- Plastic Bags
- Yard Waste
- Styrofoam®

Place cart within 3 feet of street, with lid closed and facing outward to the street.
