The amended boundaries of the land to be serviced by the Parrish Lakes Community Development District are outlined on the map depicted below, which is generally located south of Moccasin Wallow Road, north of 69<sup>th</sup> Street and Erie Road, east of I-75 and west of U.S. Hwy 301, Parrish, Manatee County, Florida. The petitioner has proposed to amend the boundaries of the Parrish Lakes Community Development District to acquire, construct, operate, and maintain all infrastructure and community facilities which may be authorized by such districts under Florida law, including but not limited to water management and control, water supply, sewer, wastewater management, bridges or culverts, roads and street lights, parks and recreational facilities, security facilities, mosquito control and certain other projects when expressly approved or required by a local government.

All interested parties are invited to appear at this hearing and be heard, subject to the proper rules of conduct. Additionally, any comments filed with the Director of Development Services will be considered by the Board of County Commissioners and entered into record.
