
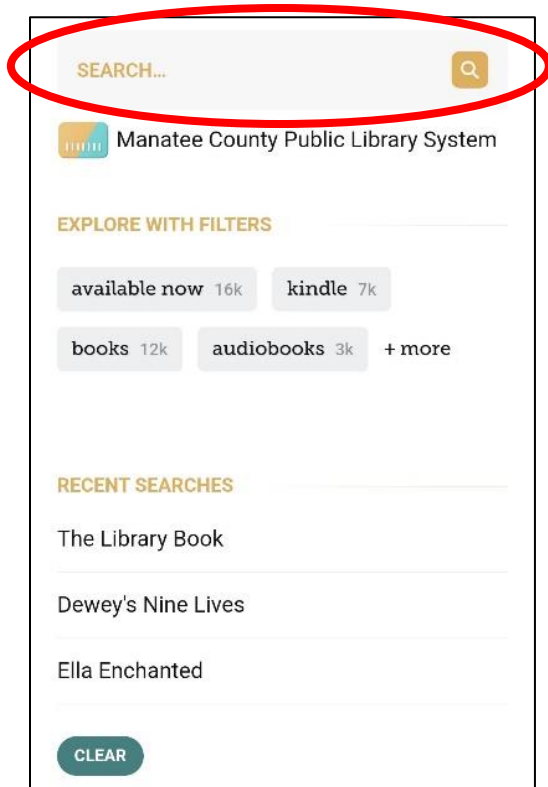
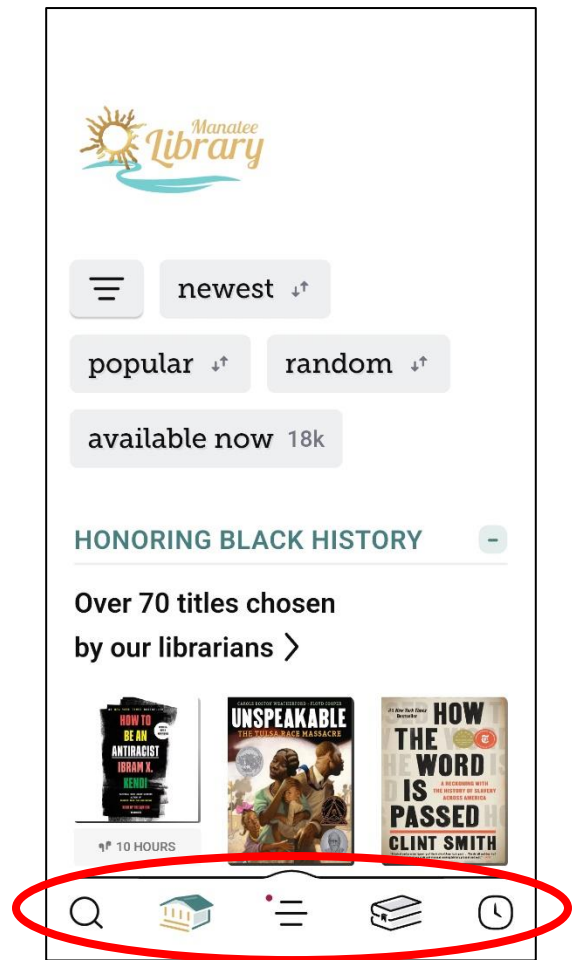



# Libby App



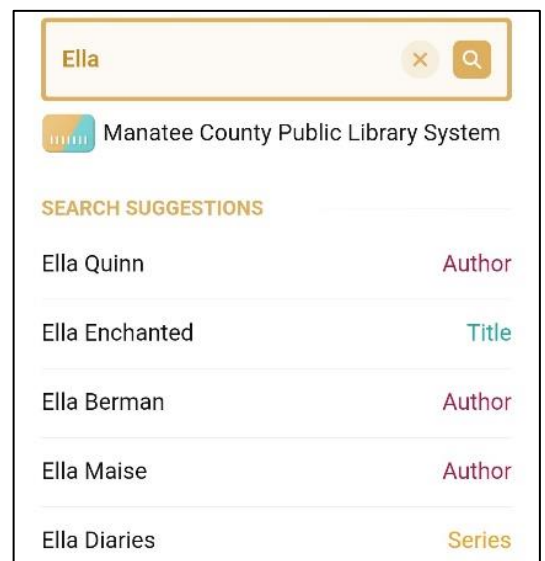
This guide will help familiarize you with the menu at the bottom of your screen.

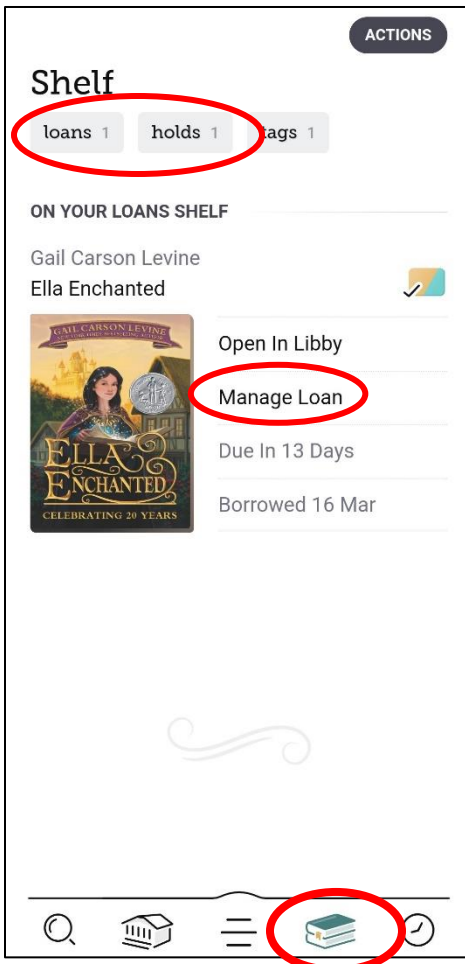
When you open the Libby app, it will open to the last thing you were doing. Tap the building icon  in the bottom menu to return to the library's page to browse for books. You can browse books that are **just added**, **popular**, **available now**, or you can browse at **random** or by **subject**. You can also scroll down your screen to view specially curated book lists.




Tap the magnifying glass icon  in the bottom menu to open the search box. Type an author name, book title, series title, or genre into the search box at the top of the screen.


After you type in a name or title, you will see many possible search suggestions. Tap on the one you are interested in to **Borrow** or **Place Hold**, depending on the book's availability.

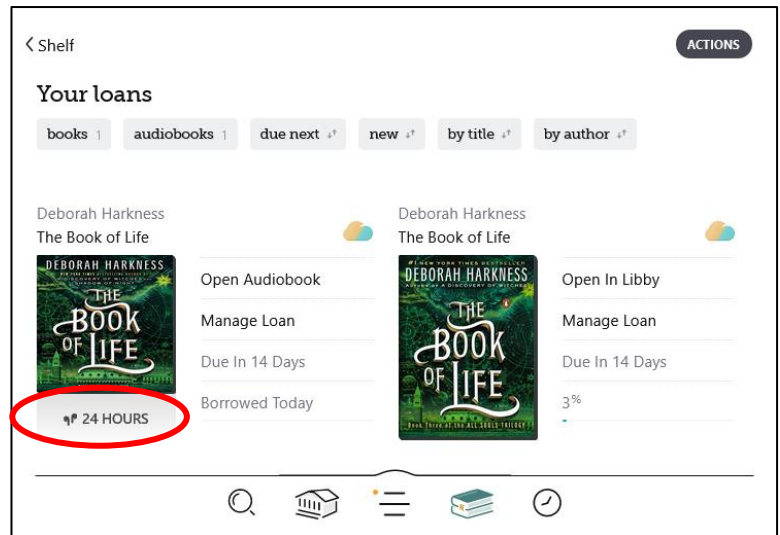





Tap the book icon  in the bottom menu to see your **loans** (books you have checked out) and **holds**.

Tap on the book's cover to open a loan and begin reading. Tap on **Manage Loan** to return or renew a book (if no one else is on hold for it).

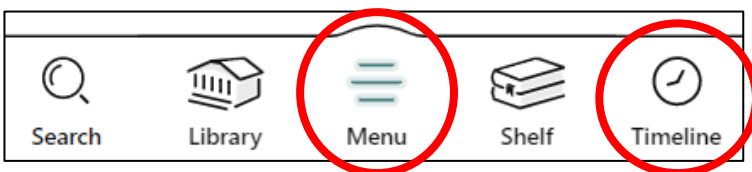
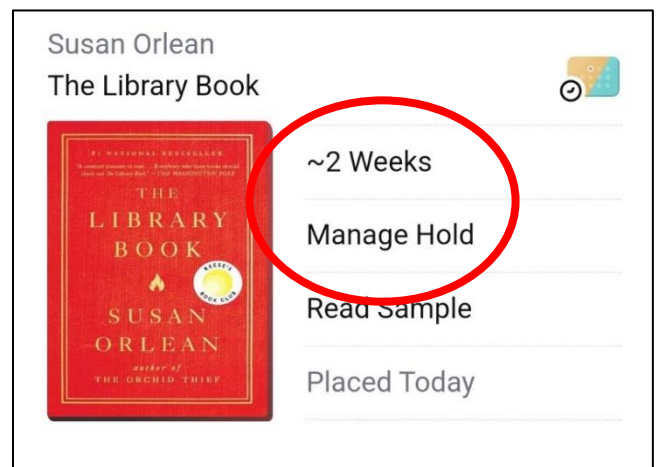
To distinguish between an e-book and e-audiobook, look for the **headphones**  symbol below the book cover. It will also include the duration of the audio.




To see your holds, tap the book icon  in the bottom menu and tap on **Holds** near the top left corner of the screen.


Your approximate wait time for the loan will be displayed to the right of the book's cover.

Tap **Manage Hold** to suspend or cancel your hold.



Tap the menu icon  to manage your notifications, update your library card, or change your settings.

**Tip:** If you want to add labels to the icons at the bottom, tap the menu icon, then tap settings. Tap Custom Navigation and turn on Labeled Icons.

Tap the clock icon  to see a timeline of all your actions and loans in Libby.
