

Group I: Manatee County Medigap Assistance

1. Establish the eligibility criteria for the program ex. Persons below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines, Manatee County resident, not eligible for any other payer support (Medicaid, Medicare, etc.), US citizen or legal alien status.
2. Establish the proof of eligibility requirements.
3. Set eligibility renewal time frames (annual, semiannual, quarterly?).
4. Analyze the patient population data from the current safety net providers.
5. Identify the potential provider network.
6. Negotiate payment rates and incentives.
7. Set the quality measures.
8. Support and educate the Provider network.
9. Set up a Third Party Administration (TPA) for provider service payment and data analytics.
10. Issue patient eligibility cards.

Group II: Silver plan

100% to 250% of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines.

This group will be referred to a private foundation for assistance with applying for a Silver plan on the health care insurance exchange and premium payment assistance.

Group III: Persons on Medicare with incomes at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines.

Referred for health care resources navigation;

- Discounted Medical Plan for patient responsibility.
- Medicare Advantage Plans
- MCR Pharmacy
- Etc.
