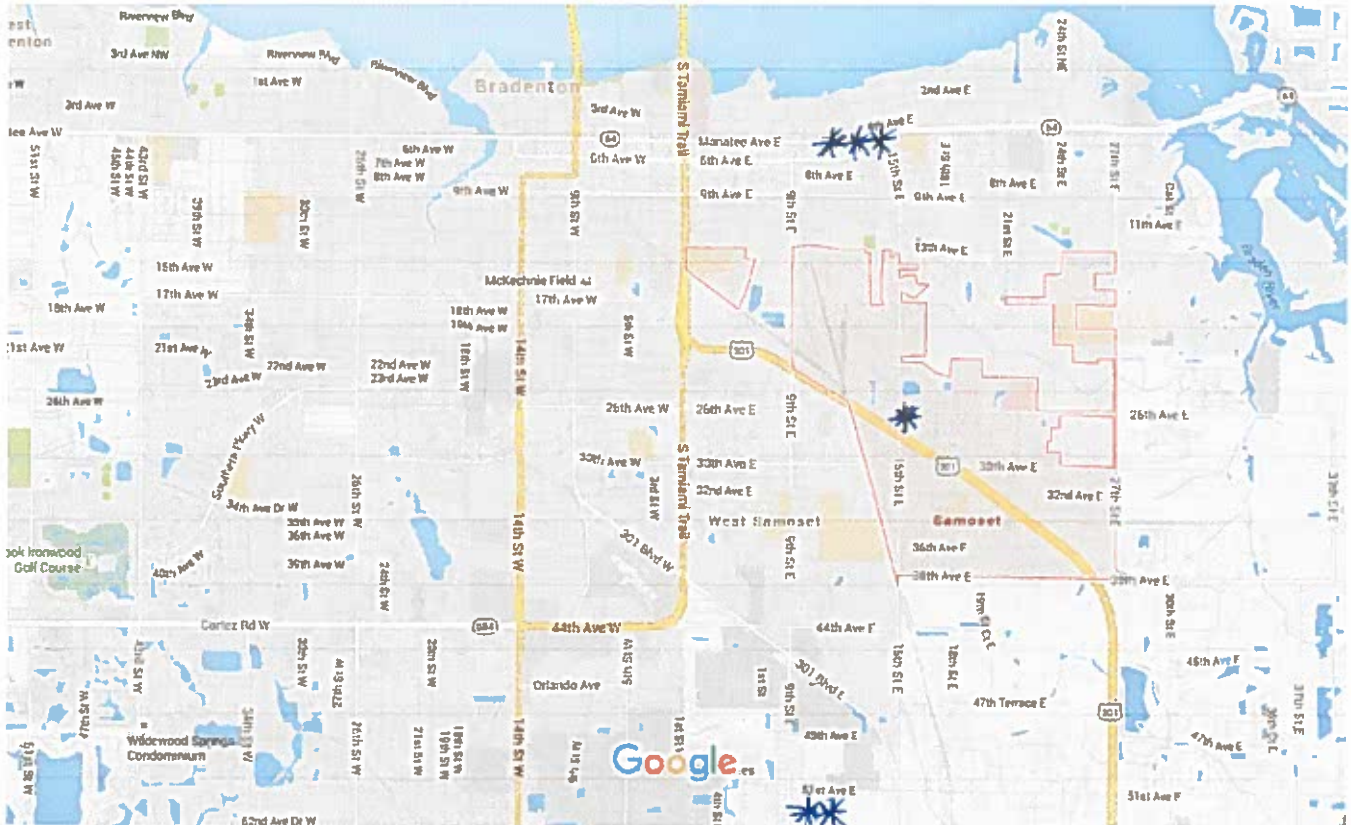

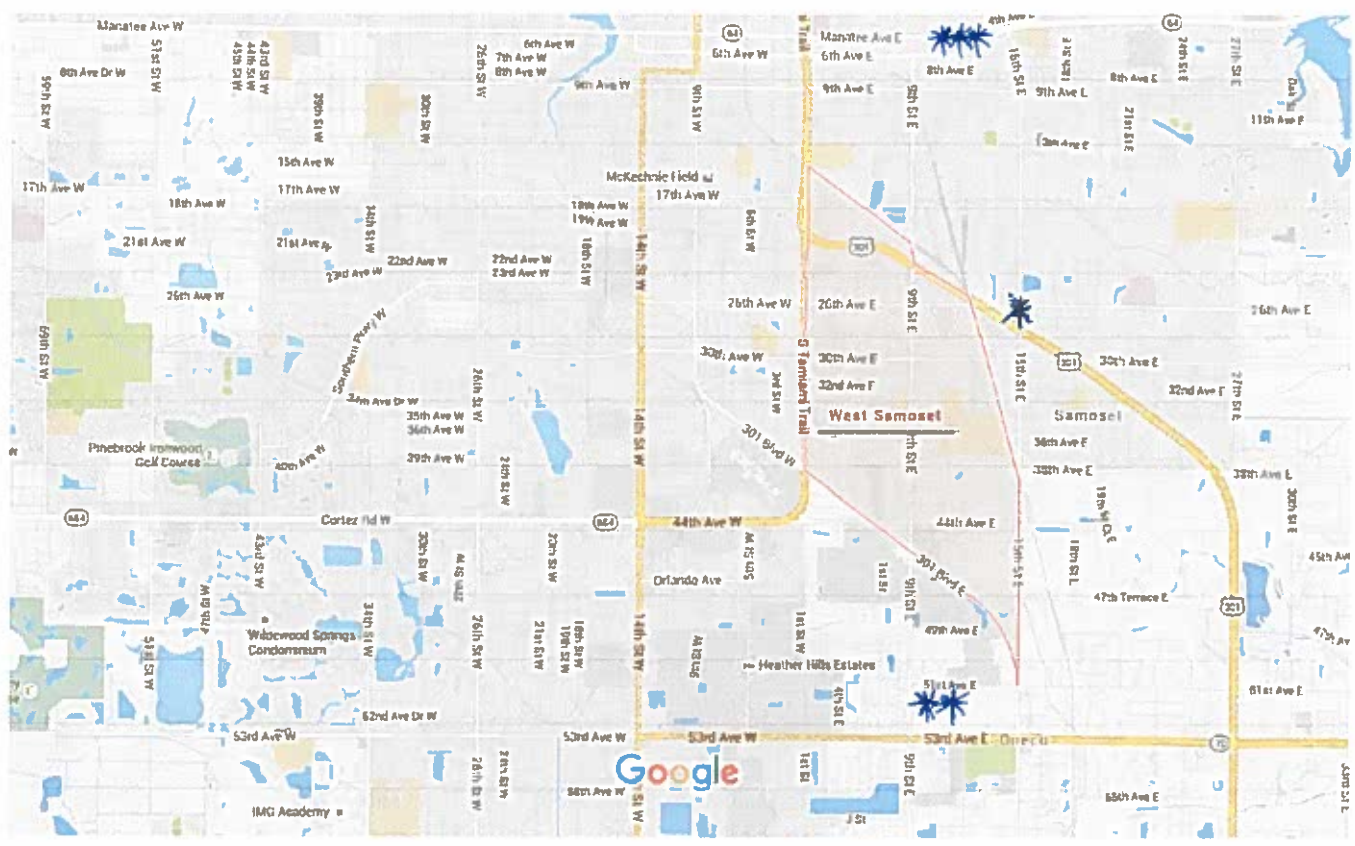

Sliding Fee Discount Schedule Guidelines

Manatee County Rural Health Services has established a schedule of discounts for services, or sliding fee discount schedule (SFDS), that ensures financial barriers to care are minimized for patients who are at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG). The sliding fee discount is a patient centered program that assures that our patients have access to all services under scope, regardless of their ability to pay. The sliding fee schedule provides discounts to qualified patients based on their family size and income. The guideline for this program include the following elements:

- Applicability to all individuals and families with annual incomes at or below 200 percent of FPG
- Nominal charge for individuals or families with annual incomes at or below 100 percent of FPG – Slide A
- Adjustment of fees based upon family size and income for individuals and families with incomes above 100 and at or below 200 percent of FPG – Slide B, Slide C, and Slide D
- No sliding fee discounts for individuals and families with annual incomes above 200 percent of FPG – Slide E
- Patients who do not provide the necessary documentation based upon the verification requirements to determine eligibility for SFDS will be considered self-pay until the time that they provide this documentation

While every reasonable effort should be made to obtain reimbursement from third party payors, including public or private health insurance, no patient will be denied health care services due to an inability to pay.

MCRHS may serve patients with third party insurances that do not cover or only partially covers fees for certain services. In such cases, subject to potential legal and contractual limitations, these patients may also be eligible for the SFDS based on income and family size. For example, *John Doe*, an insured patient, receives a health center service for which the health center has established a fee of \$80. Based on *John Doe's* insurance plan, the co-pay would be \$60 for this service. The health center has also determined, through an assessment of income and family size, that he is at 150 percent of the FPG and thus qualifies for the SFDS. Under the SFDS, a patient at 150 percent of the FPG would receive a 50 percent discount.

Summary

The four neighborhoods appear well-served from a geographic standpoint with 3 MCR locations convenient to Samoset (SAM) and W. Samoset (WSAM) and 2 MCR locations convenient to S. Bradenton (SBR) and Bayshore Gardens (BG).

Hours of operation are greater for SAM and WSAM with Chiles Family Health open Mon to Friday from 8 to 8 for a total of 60 hrs./week and E. Manatee Health open Mon to Saturday from 8 to 8 plus Sunday 9 to 5 for a total of 80 hrs./week.

In contrast, there is only evening of operation for the SBR and BG neighborhoods. If SE Family Health were to stay open on Tuesday till 8 PM – giving it 2 evenings of service and open on Saturday from 9 to 3, this would add 9 hours to its service footprint for a total of 53 hrs./week.

Bradenton Family Medical would also improve its service coverage by staying open M-W-F till 7:30 (complementing proposed Tu-Th coverage at SE Family Health) for an additional 7 hours and a total of 56 hrs. / week.

Question: Is this possible logistically from MCR's viewpoint and can funds be made available by Manatee County to support this initiative?

I have no opinion whether the type of medical service offered by the four health centers is optimum to the neighborhoods, but since all of the MCR offices offer Family Medicine plus specialties such as Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, OB/GYN, Optometry and Dental at specific locations, it would seem basic neighborhood health needs are being satisfied.

Question: As part of its existing package of medical services, can MCR also treat the 15 most common medical conditions seen at the Emergency rooms in Manatee County (as referenced by Mr. Friedrich at the January meeting)? Someone from MCR and/or the medical expertise on the Advisory Board should be able to answer this question.

Finally, a number of medically needy are on Obamacare in predominantly Bronze plans with \$5,000 to \$6,000 deductibles which force the patient to pay for medical treatment out-of-pocket. As a way for them to know the magnitude of their financial responsibility before seeking treatment, it would be helpful if MCR and other walk-in medical clinics in Manatee County posted a list of their most frequently performed medical treatments and prices prominently at the front desk. Such a "Disclosure Board" is prominently displayed at the Urgent Care Walk-In clinic at 4647 W. Manatee Avenue and also on the Manatee County Health Services website (maintained by Andy Guyre).

Question: Can a representative of the Health Advisory Board (HAB) contact MCR and the for-profit walk-in clinics to see if they would like to post their prices on the Manatee County Health Services website and also at their front desk locations?
