Fiscal Year 2026 Priorities

- Children are safe in their homes, free from abuse or neglect.
- Children develop literacy skills necessary to be successful in school.
- Children have the skills necessary to function appropriately in relevant environments.
- Parents and caregivers have the skills and resources needed to stop preventable child death.



<u>Priority A -</u> Child Welfare: Children are safe in their homes, free from abuse or neglect.

- A1 Children remain in their homes free from abuse and neglect, avoiding the need to enter or re-enter foster care.
- A2 Children who enter foster care gain a permanent, stable, and nurturing home within 12 months and remain there.



<u>Priority B - Education and Literacy: Children develop</u> literacy skills necessary to be successful in school.

- B1 Children who demonstrate below developmentally appropriate or grade level literacy skills, reduce their existing gap towards developmentally appropriate or age-appropriate literacy skills.
- B2 Children who attain grade level or developmentally appropriate literacy skills, will maintain grade level or developmentally appropriate literacy skills.



<u>Priority C - Mental and Behavioral Health/Wellbeing: Children have the skills necessary to function appropriately in relevant environments.</u>

- C1 Children with symptoms of adverse indicators of behavioral health as identified objectively by a measure of level of functioning determined by the program, will build protective factors.
- C2 Children who use drugs, alcohol, or other illegal substances, or are at risk of use, will stop or resist use, and establish a plan to manage triggers.

(Continued) Priority C - Mental and Behavioral Health/Wellbeing: Children have the skills necessary to function appropriately in relevant environments.

- C3 Children with one or more incidents of referral or suspension for aggression, bullying, harassment, or other negative action aimed towards another group or individual, will reduce those incidents.
- C4 Children will learn and demonstrate appropriate social, emotional, and impulse control and regulation skills in relevant environments as identified objectively by a measure of level of functioning as determined by the program.

<u>Priority D:</u> Health and Safety: Parents and caregivers have the skills and resources needed to stop preventable child death

- D1 Children will be safely placed to sleep in accordance with the Sleep Baby Safely initiative implemented by Manatee County.
- D2 Children and families will implement water safety practices at home and in all environments where water safety is a concern.



Fiscal Year 2026 Priorities and Targets

A program does **NOT** have to meet an established priority to be considered or to receive a recommendation for investment through Children's Services funding.



Application Requirements

Qualifiers to access Children's Services Results First and Results as Services applications:

Insurance Requirement: Commercial General Liability Coverage (not to be less than \$1 million per occurrence).

- Ordinance #91-42
- Prohibition of supplanting
- Resolution 23-145 regarding abortion services
- Florida Statutes sections 448.095(5) and 125.0156 regarding E-Verify
- Financial Audit (less than 2 years old)

Application Requirements

- Other requirements for contractual compliance include, but are not limited to:
 - Not-for-profit status
 - Valid tax-exempt status
 - Client Eligibility
 - Client Consent
 - Program data and client records maintenance




