Financial assistance is available for:

- Utilities, FPL, and TECO, eviction prevention, and other basic needs funds are available for qualified applicants.
- Rental assistance for qualified applicants only when funding is available.
- A limited number of applications can be accepted for financial assistance. Assistance is subject to approval and is not guaranteed.
