Background Discussion

Manatee County is an entitlement community through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs.

HUD approved Manatee County's 2023-2028 Consolidated Plan in October 2023. The programming goals identified by Manatee County for the five-year entitlement funding cycle include: Goal 1 - Increase access to affordable housing; Goal 2 - Reduce homelessness in Manatee County; Goal 3 - Support health care and wellbeing activities for special needs populations; Goal 4 - Provide access to community supportive services and economic development opportunities; and Goal 5 - Expand Community Development Strategies.

In preparation for the FY 2026/27 HUD funding cycle, a grant application workshop was held on March 2nd, 2026, and a Q&A Session on March 19, 2026, with interested organizations in attendance. Applications for funding were due on March 31st, 2026.

In April 2026, staff conducted a review of the completeness of all grant applications received by the deadline to ensure they met the threshold requirements outlined in the application. An Application Review Committee of nine county staff, as well as one member of the Suncoast Partnership to End Homelessness, Inc (Continuum of Care Lead Agency), and one member of the Manatee County Housing Authority, was convened to review each application. Applications were scored by each reviewer based on the priority needs, goals, and strategies identified in the five-year Consolidated Plan, and the needs and gaps. Application scoring criteria also included collaboration/partnerships, leveraging of other funds, performance measures, and outcomes, among other criteria.

Manatee County anticipates that its funding allocation from HUD for FY 2026/27 will be as follows: CDBG \$1,981,290.00; HOME \$623,460.88; and ESG \$161,149.00. County staff has also identified an additional \$357,227.00 in Prior Year CDBG funds available for reallocation.

Based upon priority needs and available funding, the Review Committee recommends funding to eleven CDBG-eligible activities, three HOME-eligible activities, and one ESG-eligible activity.

The 2026/27 Application Recommendation Summary of proposed projects and activities is presented for the Board's consideration and approval on June 2nd, 2026, for inclusion into the FY 2026/27 Annual Action Plan. Following approval of the proposed projects and activities, the draft 2026/27 HUD Annual Action Plan will be finalized, and the 30-day public comment period, commencing on June 29th, 2026, will be advertised.

The FY 2026/27 Annual Action Plan will be scheduled for a public hearing and approval at the BCC on July 28th, 2026. We will submit the FY 2026/27 Annual Action Plan to HUD no later than August 16, 2026, as required by HUD.

The Review Committee for the FY 2026/27 CDBG / HOME / ESG Funding Applications convened on April 28th, 2026, to define the final funding recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners.

The Review Committee was formed by the following individuals:

Each reviewer scored the individual applications using the Neighborly application system. Determinants of funding recommendations included the following: alignment with grant rules and objectives, available funding, Consolidated Plan Priority Needs, average scores for project objectives and narrative descriptions, project readiness and feasibility, supporting documentation, past performance, and current open contracts/funding.

Based on these components, the Review Committee recommends funding eleven CDBG-eligible activities, three HOME-eligible activities, and one ESG-eligible activity.

A total of 10 applications are not being recommended for funding due to factors such as incompatibility with grant rules, insufficient funding, or the need for further/revised information for future application cycles.

In addition to the recommended projects, staff followed the set-asides allowed by HUD for Administration and Planning for the regular CDBG, HOME, and ESG entitlements allocations.

- 1) Non-Congregate Shelter Initiatives – Acquisition, conversion, rehabilitation, and/or construction of a non-congregate shelter facility, as defined by HUD.
- 2) Public Facility – Pre-Development components, Common Areas / Facilities Infrastructure, Exterior upgrades as needed, and other appurtenances for functioning public facilities.

HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME)

- 1) HOME-Tenant-Based Rental Assistance – Provision of Rental Assistance, rental and utility deposits as needed to low- and moderate-income Manatee County residents.
- 2) CHDO Housing Construction – Construction of single-family or multi-family homeownership or rental developments

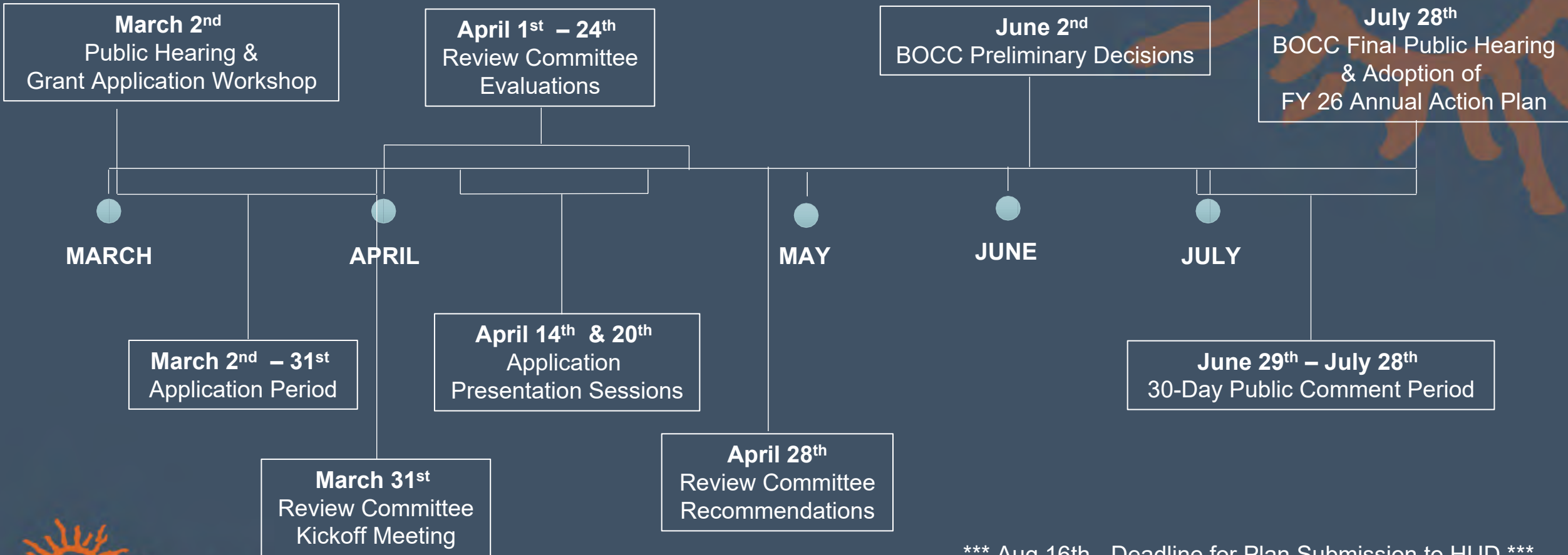
