Where applicable, wet scrape defective paint; spot prime; seal water stains; and make any minor repairs to walls and baseboard. Make sure baseboard is securely fastened to wall. Caulk cracks in baseboard and at intersection with wall surfaces using mildew resistant caulk prior to painting. Owner to select one paint color for wall surfaces and one color for baseboard.

NOTE: You need to sand all baseboards, casing, doors and any other wood work to be painted. You need to check to see if existing paint is oil based paint and if so you need to prime with proper primer to ensure that the new paint does not peel off.
