Preliminary damage inspections are limited to evaluating the extent of damage to the following:



FOUNDATIONS



ROOFS



WINDOWS & DOORS



SIDING



INSTALLED APPLIANCES



ELECTRICAL & PLUMBING



HEATING & AIR CONDITIONING



WALLS & FLOORS

SUBSTANTIAL DAMAGE: Damage of any origin sustained by a building whereby the cost of restoring the building to its pre-damaged condition which would be equal to or exceed 50% of the market value of the building before the damage occurred.

PLEASE NOTE

The cost of the repairs must include all costs necessary to fully repair the building to its before-damage condition, including labor.
