Permit Extension Request

(Set Forth by Florida Building Code – 2023 8th Edition)

105.4.1 Permit Intent

A permit issued shall be construed to be a license to proceed with the work and not as authority to violate, cancel, alter or set aside any of the provisions of the technical codes, nor shall issuance of a permit prevent the building official from thereafter requiring a correction of errors in plans, construction or violations of this code. Every permit issued shall become invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is commenced within 6 months after its issuance, or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 6 months after the time the work is commenced.

Impact fees WILL be re-assessed on all permits at the time of the extension UNLESS they have been prepaid prior to the application extension request.

What should I expect when requesting an extension?

- Issued permits beginning with BLD will be reviewed for the following:
 - 1. Inspection History
 - 2. Substantial Completion Review (as noted in FS 553.79(15))
 - 3. Related Permits
 - 4. Revisions
 - 5. Related Code Enforcement Cases and/or other violations.
 - 6. Review of Current Executive Orders Issued by the Governor
- Issued permits beginning with CMP will be reviewed for the following:
 - 1. Inspection History
 - 2. Substantial Completion Review (as noted in FS 553.79(15))
 - 3. Related Permits
 - 4. Revisions
 - 5. Related Code Enforcement Cases and/or other violations.

Who can submit an extension request?

- Contractor of Record
- Owner-Builder acting as Contractor of Record

Can I extend my permit if the status shows VOID or CANCELLED?

• No, you will need to submit a new permit application.

Can I extend my permit if it is part of a Construction Trades Board Case?

• No, expired permits that are part of a Constructions Trades Board Case cannot be extended. You will have to comply and close the permit.

What is the fee for a Permit Extension?

- A \$50.00 fee will be accessed for each 90-day extension application. Applicants may only apply for one 90-day extension at a time. Extensions will be processed and forwarded to the Inspections Manager for review. Please allow 5-7 business days for processing. If the permit has passed the expiration date a \$14 reinstatement fee will be applied.
- Submitting a permit extension application does not guarantee approval.
