**RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
TO ADOPT AN ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-
2025 FOR THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners Manatee County, Florida has considered an Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 for the Supervisor of Elections; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has held two public hearings and has caused public notice of said hearings, all in conformance with applicable State Statute and law; and,

WHEREAS, Florida Statute Section 129.011 provides that separate budgetary funds may be consolidated by resolution; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

Section 1. The Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 as approved by the Board of County Commissioners on September 12, 2024, for the Supervisor of Elections is hereby amended, and adopted including appropriations, reserves, transfers, trust funds, internal services, and cash balances which total \$4,019,615.

APPOINTED OFFICERS (continued)

- A copy of the form must be provided immediately to the other members of the agency.
- The form must be read publicly at the next meeting after the form is filed.

IF YOU MAKE NO ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE THE DECISION EXCEPT BY DISCUSSION AT THE MEETING:

- You must disclose orally the nature of your conflict in the measure before participating.
- You must complete the form and file it within 15 days after the vote occurs with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who must incorporate the form in the minutes. A copy of the form must be provided immediately to the other members of the agency, and the form must be read publicly at the next meeting after the form is filed.
