## PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS AND COMMUNITY BENEFITS

The Canal Road projects will include widening the existing two lane roadway to a four lane roadway with shoulders, street lighting, sidewalks, and/or a multi-use path on one side in lieu of bicycle lanes to provide an enhanced mobility experience for all users. Further, the realignment of Mendoza Road connecting the eastern segment, 37th Street East, to the western segment, 39th Street East, at one intersection on Canal Road will decrease conflicts at the intersection along for a safer traffic movement. The purpose for the Canal Road projects will be to enhance safety, improve traffic operations, enhance multimodal access and meet the population growth and the resulting increase in travel demand along the corridor. Pending the approval of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), the Canal Road project would also include a traffic signal at US 41. The additional roadway capacity will meet the anticipated County growth and higher traffic volumes. The Canal Road improvements provides access to safe, affordable, accessible, and sustainable mobility for all roadway users.

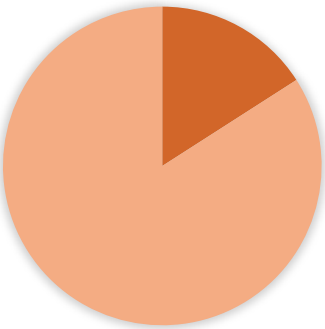
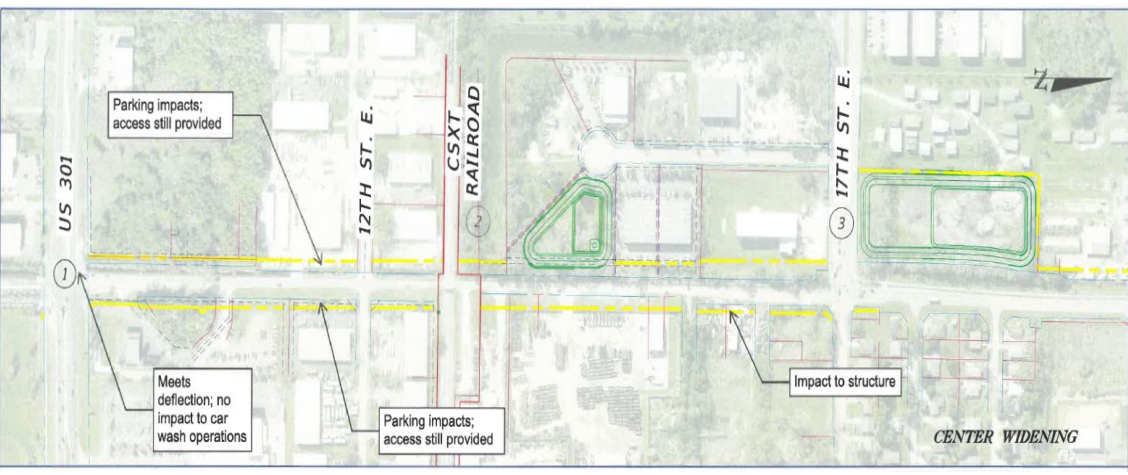
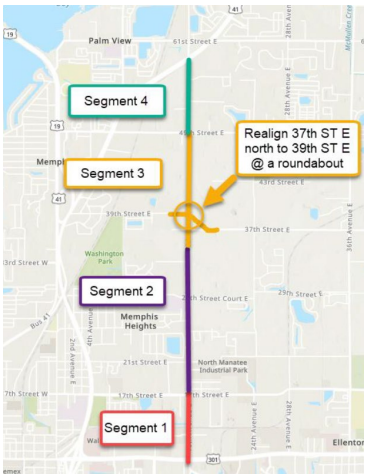
