The Erie Road Improvements project consists of the reconstruction of Erie Road, an east-west route through the community of Parrish. The east segment of this project will widen approximately one mile of Erie Road from Martha Road to US 301 from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) separated by a 22-foot-wide raised median and curb and gutter on both sides. A shared-use path will be constructed on the south side of Erie Road. A HAWK system, or high emphasis crosswalk signal, will also be constructed at Martha Road. Additional enhancements include median lighting and construction of a fully closed drainage system with stormwater ponds. The west segment of this project will widen approximately 2.3 miles of Erie Road from 69th Street East to Martha Road from two lanes to four lanes (two in each direction) separated by a 22-foot-wide raised median and curb and gutter on both sides. A shared-use path will be constructed on the south side of Erie Road. The project also includes construction of two roundabouts: at Harrison Ranch Road and at Sawgrass Road. Additional enhancements include street lighting installed in the median and construction of a fully closed drainage system with stormwater ponds.


