PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS AND COMMUNITY BENEFITS

With the Lincoln Improvement Projects the park will feature a splashpad, locker rooms, upgraded pool and pool deck, a new picnic pavilion and fencing and LED field lighting. The parking lot will be renovated to include additional parking spaces. The soccer field will get two new shade structures and the football field will get four new shade structures. Two regulation basketball courts will be constructed with fencing, lighting, benches, trash cans and more. The pool area of the park is being upgraded to include a larger deck, picnic pavilion and a splash pad. Future improvements include a Pedestrian Bridge across the US 41/17th Street E intersection. The park also has a paved 1/2 mile multi-purpose trail. In February 2022 the Board of County Commissioners unanimously voted to rename Lincoln Park to Coach Eddie Shannon Park in honor of Eddie Shannon a true hometown hero.

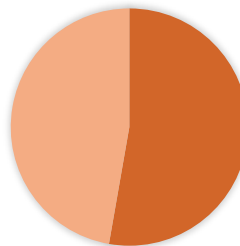
