Moccasin Wallow Road is an important east-west connection and evacuation route for the rapidly growing North County area. In addition, Moccasin Wallow Road provides an important economic function and benefit by connecting SeaPort Manatee to the state roadway transportation network.

The Moccasin Wallow Road widening project consists of four (4) segments totaling 6.5 miles of roadway between U.S. 41 and U.S. 301. The current project will add two lanes to Moccasin Wallow Road but is being designed so that additional lanes can be constructed when needed to accommodate future development.

The first, or interim, phase of the project will widen Moccasin Wallow Road from 2lanes to 4-lanes (2 in each direction). The final, or ultimate, phase of the project will widen Moccasin Wallow Road from 4-lanes to 6-lanes (3 in each direction). The project will also replace the current intersection at Moccasin Wallow Road and U.S. 301 with a roundabout for more efficient traffic flow and improved safety. Ultimately, the Moccasin Wallow Road Improvements will improve safety for all roadway users along Moccasin Wallow Road by providing additional road capacity to meet anticipated County growth and higher traffic volumes, bicycle lanes, sidewalk, and a shared use path.
