

CITY OF BRADENTON BEACH DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Chapter 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes, gives authority to political subdivisions To declare and enact a State of Local Emergency for a period of up to seven (7) days, thereby waiving the procedures and formalities otherwise required of the political subdivision by law, and;

WHEREAS, Hurricane Elsa may require extraordinary and immediate actions by the City of Bradenton Beach in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare;


THEREFORE, as Mayor of the City of Bradenton Beach, pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Mayor by virtue of Article II, Section 3, Duties and powers of the Mayor and Vice Mayor, of The Charter of the City of Bradenton Beach in order "to ensure compliance with the emergency preparedness and emergency management programs and requirements for the City," I hereby declare a State of Local Emergency that will continue for seven (7) days or if cancelled before that period of time. This Local State of Emergency includes all of the City of Bradenton Beach.

Pursuant to this Declaration, the Department Heads and Police Lieutenant, John Cosby, are hereby ordered to take whatever prudent actions are necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community.
