Subject: Hurricane Helene (Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine) Local State of Emergency Extension

Per Ordinance 24-82, the state of local emergency may be renewed in order to continue to protect the public’s health, safety, and welfare by issuance of a memorandum declaring extension of the local state of emergency by either the County Administrator or the Director.

It has been determined that renewal of a state of local emergency issued for Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine (PTC Nine) – Hurricane Helene is necessary as the local emergency continues to exist.

The procedures and formalities waived by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Resolution No. R-24-193 and Extension Memos through 11.26.2024 is hereby extended and shall continue until midnight on December 10, 2024, unless further extended in accordance with Florida law and the County’s Disaster Emergency Management Ordinance.
