Subject: Hurricane Milton (Potential Tropical Low) Local State of Emergency Extension

Per Ordinance 24-82, the state of local emergency may be renewed in order to continue to protect the public’s health, safety, and welfare by issuance of a memorandum declaring extension of the local state of emergency by either the County Administrator or the Director.

It has been determined that renewal of a state of local emergency issued for Potential Tropical Cyclone Low – Hurricane Milton is necessary as the local emergency continues to exist.

The procedures and formalities waived by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Resolution No. R-24-198 is hereby extended and shall continue until midnight on October 18, 2024, unless further extended in accordance with Florida law and the County’s Disaster Emergency Management Ordinance.
