



BULK COLLECTION PILOT PROGRAM

Beginning May 1, 2026

Monthly Bulk Collection

Residents can put two (2) bulk items at the curbside for disposal once per month on their predetermined scheduled regular collection day.

You can find your new monthly bulk collection day on the Resident Information Tool; just scan the QR code or visit mymanatee.org/bigbin.

Annual Bulk Collection

Residents can schedule one (1) bulk collection once per year (per property) via their Customer Self-Service Portal (mymanatee.org/css) or calling 311. Bulk items may not exceed 10 cubic yards. Find program specifics for material type, such as tires and white goods, at mymanatee.org/bigbin.

NOTE: Our Bulk Collection Pilot Program is free for residents. There are no added fees or changes to your utility bill.

COMMON BULK ITEMS ACCEPTED

- Furniture
- Grills (NO Propane)
- Appliances*
- Tires*

NOTE: Separate bulk items by type: white goods, tires, household bulk items, etc.
