

Manatee County Utilities Missed Garbage Complaints

This can be used to report missed garbage, recycling, or yard waste services for residential properties. Please ensure the following before reporting a missed pick up:

- All items must be out within 3 feet of the roadway by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled service day and must be bagged, bundled, or canned in containers with handles.
- Yard waste must be bagged, canned, or bundled (no longer than 4 feet in length) using rope, string, tie, or tape.
- Missed pickups MUST be reported the next business day.

**Please note that as of October 1st, yard waste MUST be canned, bundled, or in lawn and leaf compostable paper kraft bags. (We will no longer be picking up plastic yard waste bags.)
