



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Data for Unregulated Contaminants

The Manatee County Utilities Department sampled the drinking water for a series of thirty unregulated contaminants (U.C.) in 2024 as required by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). U.C. are those that do not have a drinking water standard set by the EPA. The purpose of monitoring for these U.C. is to help the EPA decide whether the contaminants should be regulated in the future to protect public health. As a consumer of drinking water, you have the right to know that this data is available.

Samples for the analysis of lithium and 29 PFAS were collected during quarterly sampling from the finished drinking water in year 2024. Below is a table with the U.C. that were tested for and the corresponding results. All results were below the minimum reporting levels (MRLs) set by the EPA.
