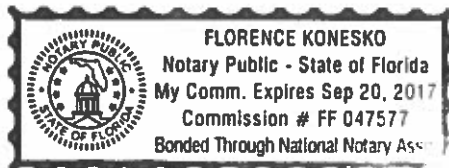

The Assessment of Fair Housing (AFH) is a legal requirement that Manatee County and the Manatee County Housing Authority (MCHA) must complete in order to continue receiving federal housing and community development funding from the U.S. Dept. of Housing & Urban Development (HUD). Specifically, the AFH is an analysis undertaken pursuant to 24 CFR Part 5.154 that includes an analysis of fair housing data, an assessment of fair housing issues and contributing factors, and an identification of fair housing priorities and goals specific to Manatee County and the MCHA. Examples of fair housing issues include regional demographics, segregation, racially and ethnically concentrated areas of poverty, access to opportunity, disproportionate housing needs, publicly supported housing, access to persons with disabilities, and fair housing enforcement and outreach capacity.

Notice of Plan Availability

Manatee County and the Manatee County Housing Authority have prepared a draft AFH. The Plan is available to the public on October 29, 2016. This notice is being published to make citizens aware that a formal 45 calendar day comment period commences on October 29, 2016, and will conclude on December 13, 2016.
