

RESOLUTION NO. R-18-022

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING REVISED BUILDING PERMIT, INSPECTION, MISCELLANEOUS FEES AND CHARGES; ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE OF BUILDING PERMIT, INSPECTION, MISCELLANEOUS AND OTHER RELATED FEES AND CHARGES FOR UNINCORPORATED MANATEE COUNTY PROVIDING DIRECTIONS REGARDING CODIFICATION; REPEALING AND SUPERSEDING CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 125.56(2), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of each county to provide a schedule of reasonable inspection fees in order to defer the costs of inspection and enforcement of the provision of the Florida Building Code; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 553.80(7), Florida Statutes, authorizes the governing bodies of local governments to provide a schedule of reasonable fees for the enforcement of provisions of Chapter 553, Part IV, Florida Statutes, the Florida Building Code; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 553.80(7), Florida Statutes, provides that such fees shall be used solely for carrying out the local government's responsibilities in enforcing the Florida Building Code; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 553.80(7), Florida Statutes, specifies the costs which may be funded with fees adopted for enforcing the Florida Building Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 109.1 of the 2017 Sixth (6th) Edition Florida Building Code prohibits the issuance of a permit until fees authorized under Section 553.80, Florida Statutes, have been paid; and

WHEREAS, Section 109.2 of the 2017 Sixth (6th) Edition Florida Building Code requires a fee for each permit to be paid, in accordance with the schedule as established by the applicable governing authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to exercise the power to carry on the county government, provided that such power is not inconsistent with general or special law; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County incurs costs for miscellaneous services provided by Building and Development Services Department staff, including issuing permits for driveways, commercial non -

structural fences, and temporary uses, notarizing documents, researching building and land use issues, and reviewing plans for compliance with zoning requirements; and

WHEREAS, Section 553.721, Florida Statutes, requires collection of a surcharge on any permit issued and remittance of the surcharge to the State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation for the purpose of funding said department and the Florida Building Commission; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 468.631(1), Florida Statutes, requires collection of a surcharge on any permit issued and remittance of the surcharge to the State of Florida Department of Business Regulation for the purpose of funding the Florida Homeowners' Construction Recovery Fund and the Building Code Administrators and Inspectors board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to have such cost paid for by persons utilizing the services; and

WHEREAS, Manatee County Building and Development Services Department has reviewed and recommended approval of the schedule of building permit , inspection, miscellaneous fees and other related fees and charges proposed in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County has determined that the schedule of building permit, inspection, miscellaneous fees and other related fees and charges established in this resolution is necessary to defer the costs of inspection and enforcement of the Florida Building Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Building permit, inspection, miscellaneous fees, and other related fees and charges. The Board of County Commissioners hereby establishes revised building permit, inspection, miscellaneous fees, and other related fees and charges to defer the costs of inspection and enforcement of the Florida Building Code. The following schedule of building permit, inspection, miscellaneous fees and other related fees and charges is hereby established for unincorporated Manatee County:

The Fee for each permit listed above includes all inspections required by the Florida Building Code and issuance of a certificate of occupancy or certificate of completion.

In addition to the fee for each permit listed above, surcharges shall be assessed and collected on any permit issued based on the rates and/or amounts specified in Subsection 468.631(1) and Section 553.721, Florida Statutes.

A permit issued for any residential or commercial structure will be eligible for a reduction of the applicable permit fee listed above in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the fee for new construction or for any replacement, renovation, alteration, or extension which exceeds fifty percent (50%) of the total footprint area of the original structure if the building complies with standards for a sustainable building. To qualify for the reduction, an architect, engineer, or other professional must certify the plans or provide a certification with the plans for the structure at the time the application for a building permit is submitted and before the fees for the building permit are paid. The certification shall state that the structure meets or exceeds the criteria for a sustainable building rating system, including, but not limited to, the United States Green Building Council (USGBC), Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED), International Green Construction Code (IGCC), Green Building Initiative's Green Globes, Florida Green Building Coalition (FGBC), or other similar standards established by a nationally recognized organization.

REFUNDS	No refunds will be issued unless the total amount exceeds \$150. All refunds will be processed at 50% of the total permitting fees collected. No refund will be issued if work has commenced or if the permit has become inactive or expired. No refunds shall be granted for permits exceeding six months from the application/issue date. If a refund is being issued to the customer due to an error by the County, it will be at 100% of the permitting fees. The Building & Development Services Department can only refund permit fees; all impact fees, fire fees, and utility fees must be refunded by their respective departments. All refund requests must be accompanied by a validated receipt or cancelled check, and a written statement showing the reason for the refund. Refund checks will be made payable to the person/company/contractor that made the payment.

The building permit fee and state fee must be paid in full at the time of permit application.

All building departments are required to collect a 2.5 percent fee on all permits. The minimum amount collected on any permit will be \$4.00. The fee is required by Florida Statutes to be collected for, in part to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) to fund the Florida Building Commission and secondly, to fund the Building Code Administrators and Inspectors Board (BCAIB) and the Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB) Homeowners Recovery Fund, both part of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR).

A Private Provider Discount of 75% will be applied to the permit fee if the customer is using a registered private provider.

Section 2. Directions regarding codification. This resolution shall not be codified in the Manatee County Code of Resolutions.

Section 3. Conflicting Resolutions. Effective February 27, 2018, all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this resolution, including, but not limited to, Resolution No.

R-16-101, shall be repealed, rescinded, superseded, and replaced by this resolution to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Severability. In the event that any provision, portion or section of this resolution is determined to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall in no manner affect the remaining provisions, portions or section of this resolution which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective date. This resolution and the fee and charges established in this resolution which shall take effect February 27, 2018.
