System Master Plan Manatee County and School Board Fiber Optic Conduit System

Reference: INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT TO CREATE A JOINT MANATEE COUNTY FIBER OPTIC CONDUIT SYSTEM, dated March 20, 2007; by and between the School Board of Manatee County ("the Board") and Manatee County ("the COUNTY")

In accordance with the Reference above, the County Administrator and the School Board Superintendent agree to the following credit adjustment(s) related to the following conduit asset(s) within the System.

- ADD conduit asset(s) to the System
- CHANGE/MOVE conduit asset(s) of the System
- REPAIR conduit asset(s) of the System

Location / Description of the affected conduit asset(s):

Changes to the System Master Plan include the following:

- County agrees to pay for the cost to relocate approximately 8,850 linear feet of conduit starting approximately 5,700 feet south of the SR64 and Lorraine Road intersection; and extending southward to the SR70 and Lorraine Road intersection at an estimated cost of \$150,444.
- School Board and County agree to add the Rye Road Conduit to the System Master Plan for shared usage in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement. The conduit starts at the intersection of SR64 and Rye Road extending northward for approximately 3,500 linear feet to the intersection of Rye Road and Waterline Road.
- School Board agrees to maintain a current CJIS Certification for each employee who is granted unescorted access by the County to the Public Safety Complex for the sole purpose of Data Center Access on an as-needed basis to perform equipment maintenance and support activities. The School Board further agrees that failure to ensure such certification will be cause for termination by the County of unescorted access.

- County agrees to waive the following outstanding invoices for completed work in the total amount of \$134,722 in accordance with the agreements contained herein:
 - \$37,743.10 – SR70 & Greenbrook BLVD (Relocate Conduit & Fiber – Feb 2017)
 - \$22,255.64 – SR64 & Rye RD Roundabout (Project Completion – July 2017 – 2019)
 - \$49,500.00 – 144CT Fiber (Purchase for Inventory - May 2019)
 - \$ 4,330.00 – SR 64 & Rye RD (Fiber Optic Repair – March 2019)
 - \$20,893.38 – Lakewood Ranch BLVD & SR70 (Fiber Conduit Repair – June 2018)

- County agrees to pay the cost of conduit repair in the amount of \$425,098 for damaged School Board conduit starting at the intersection of SR64 and Lena Road extending eastward approximately 21,200 linear feet to the intersection of SR64 and Lorraine Road; and for damaged School Board conduit starting at the intersection of SR70 and Lakewood Ranch Boulevard extending eastward approximately 10,700 linear feet to the intersection of SR70 and Lorraine Road. Upon completion of the conduit repair, the County will invoice the School Board in the amount of \$130,000 on or before June 30, 2021; and the School Board agrees to provide a future credit to County in the amount of \$20,444 as documented in the County Credit Adjustment below.

- School Board and County agree to add the following sections of conduit to the System Master Plan for shared usage in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement.
 - SR64 & Lena Road to SR64 & Lorraine Road – approximately 21,200 linear feet
 - SR70 & Lakewood Ranch Blvd to SR70 & Lorraine Road – approximately 10,700 linear feet
 - SR64 & Lorraine Road to SR70 & Lorraine Road – approximately 16,000 linear feet

- School Board agrees to waive the credit in the amount of \$21,135 previously owed by the County to the School Board for shared usage of the Robinson Preserve conduit in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement and the document dated May 22, 2017 (2017.05.22.1); and that this document and the agreements contained herein supersedes it in its entirety.

- County agrees to continue the practice of performing locate services for the School Board at no additional cost. School Board agrees and understands that this service is not unique to the School Board, rather a county-wide service that is offered at no cost as part of the County's 811 One Call process. School Board agrees and understands that this practice is not a commitment in perpetuity, and County agrees to notify in advance of any intent to invoice for such services should that occur at some point in the future.


