# COVID-19 Update

- **33.2 million global cases** (Increase of 4.2 million since 09/15/2020)
- **7.1 million cases in the USA with over 200,000 deaths**  
(Increase of over 600,000 cases and 6,000 deaths since 09/15/2020)
- **692,962 cases in Florida with 14,037 deaths** (Increase of 34,759 cases and 1,395 deaths since 09/15/2020)
- **11,368 cases in Manatee County Residents with 291 deaths** (Increase of 551 cases and 16 deaths since 09/15/2020)



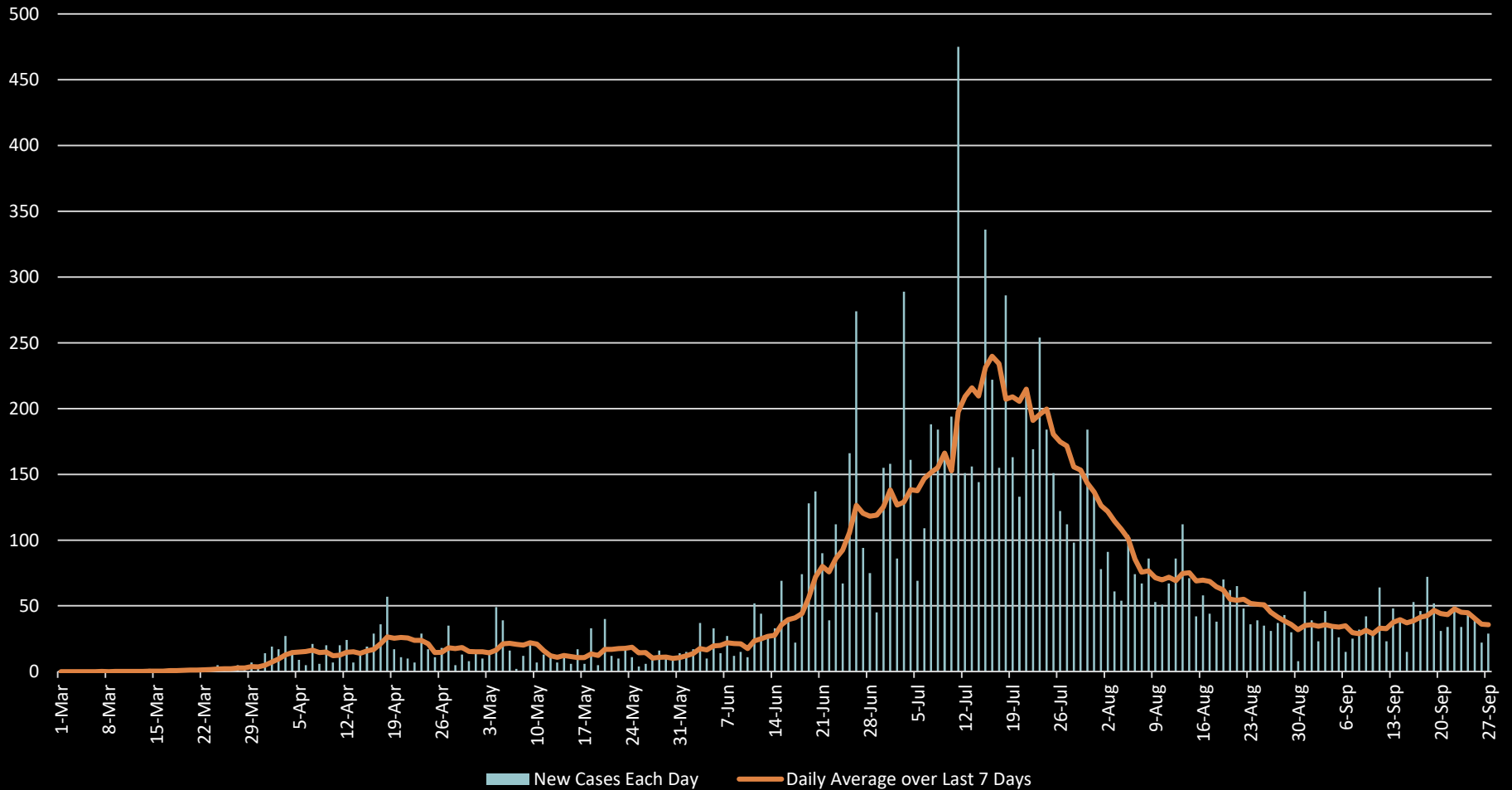
# COVID-19 Update

- 3.4% positive rate for tests in the last 14 days (10.2% on July 26)
- 3.5% positive rate for tests in the past 7 days (9.0% on July 26)
- 28 new COVID-19 hospitalizations since September 15
- 5.3 EMS calls per day related to COVID on average in the last week
- The Non-Congregate Shelter has closed due to lack of usage (opened on July 24)
- EOC remains at Level 2 Activation

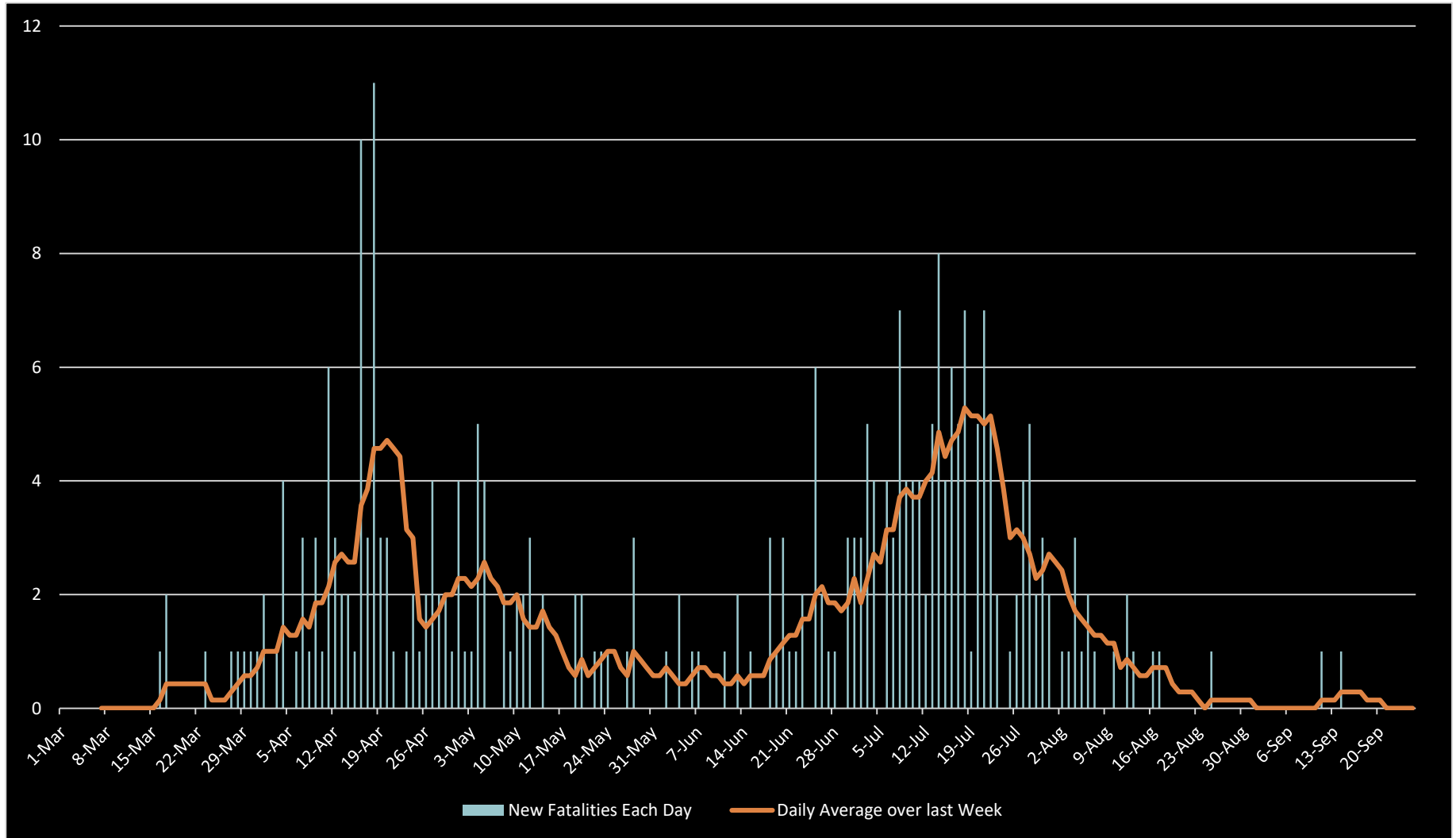


# Positive Cases by Date - Manatee County

Manatee County - Daily Case Count by Official Diagnosis Date and 7-Day Running Average

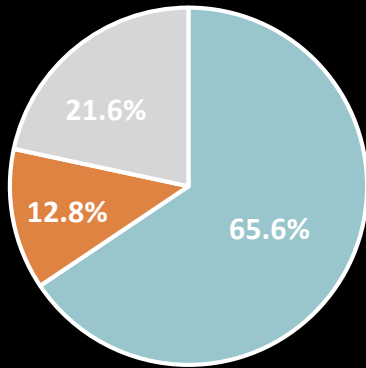


# Fatalities by Date - Manatee County



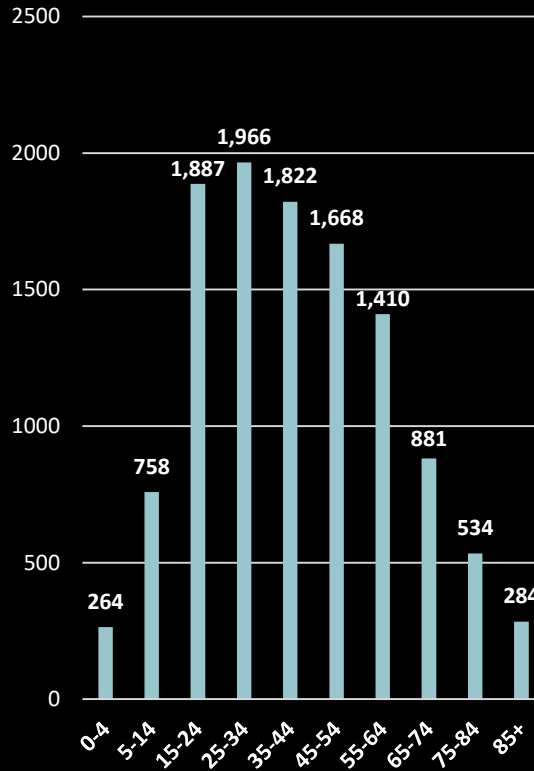

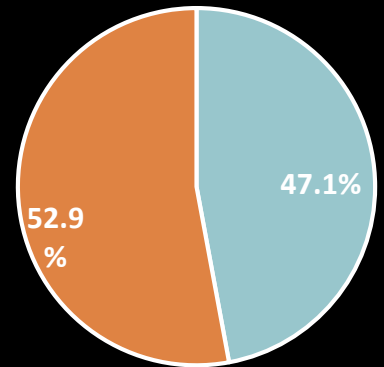
**Positive Cases by Age Group - Manatee County**



Median Age: 39 Years Old

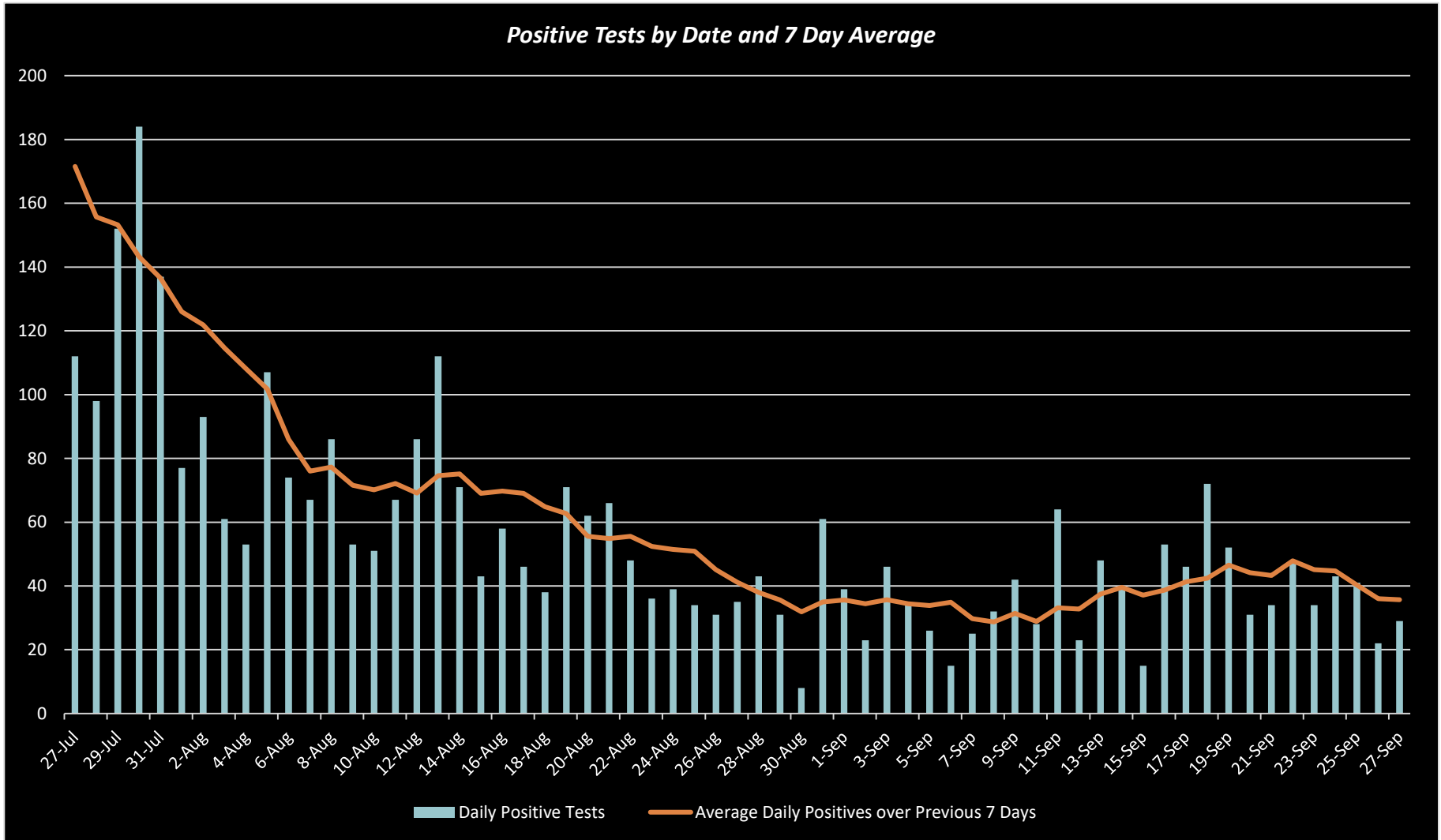
9 Cases with Unknown Sex

**Positive Cases by Sex**

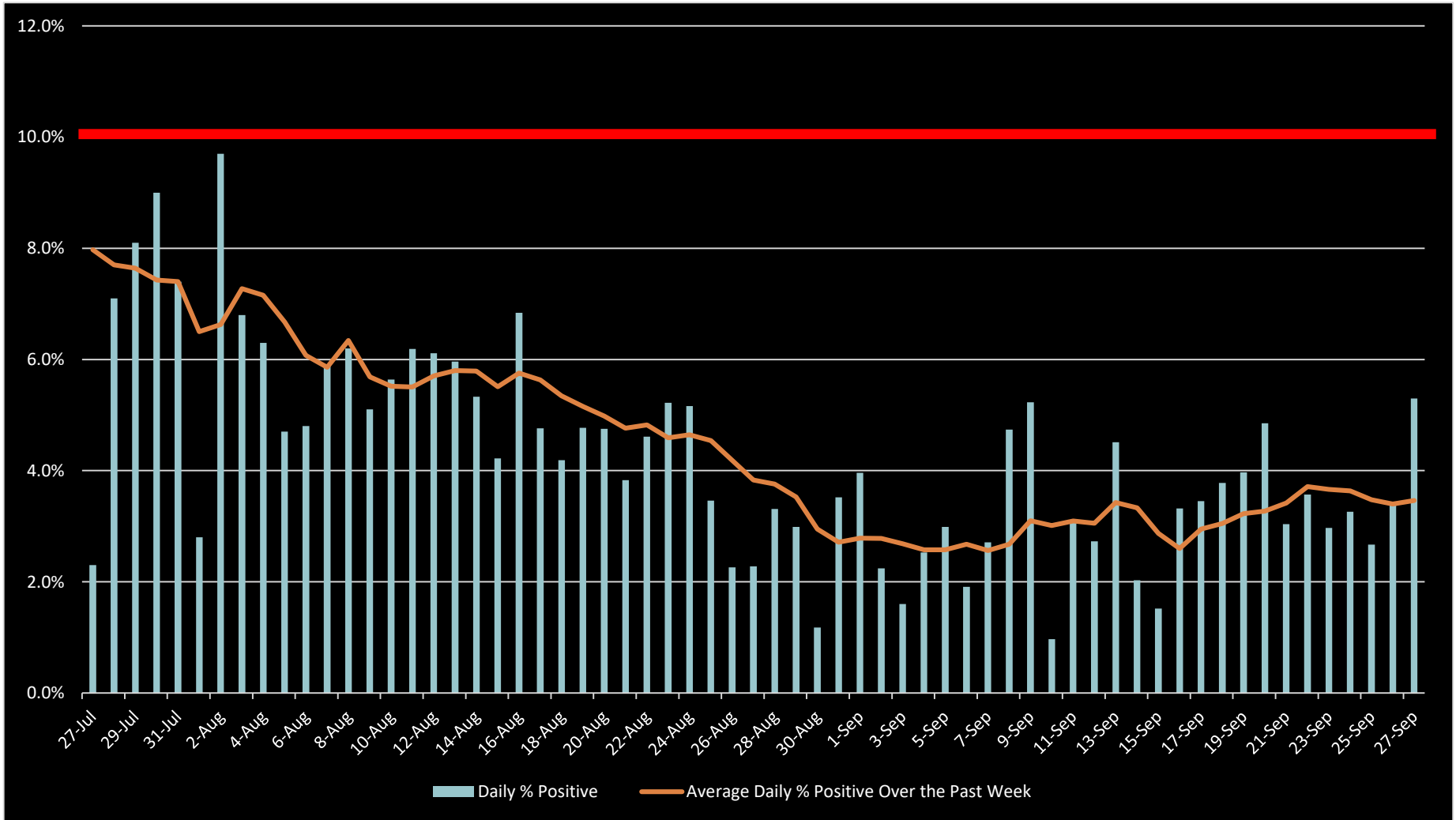

# Mask Resolution Impacts



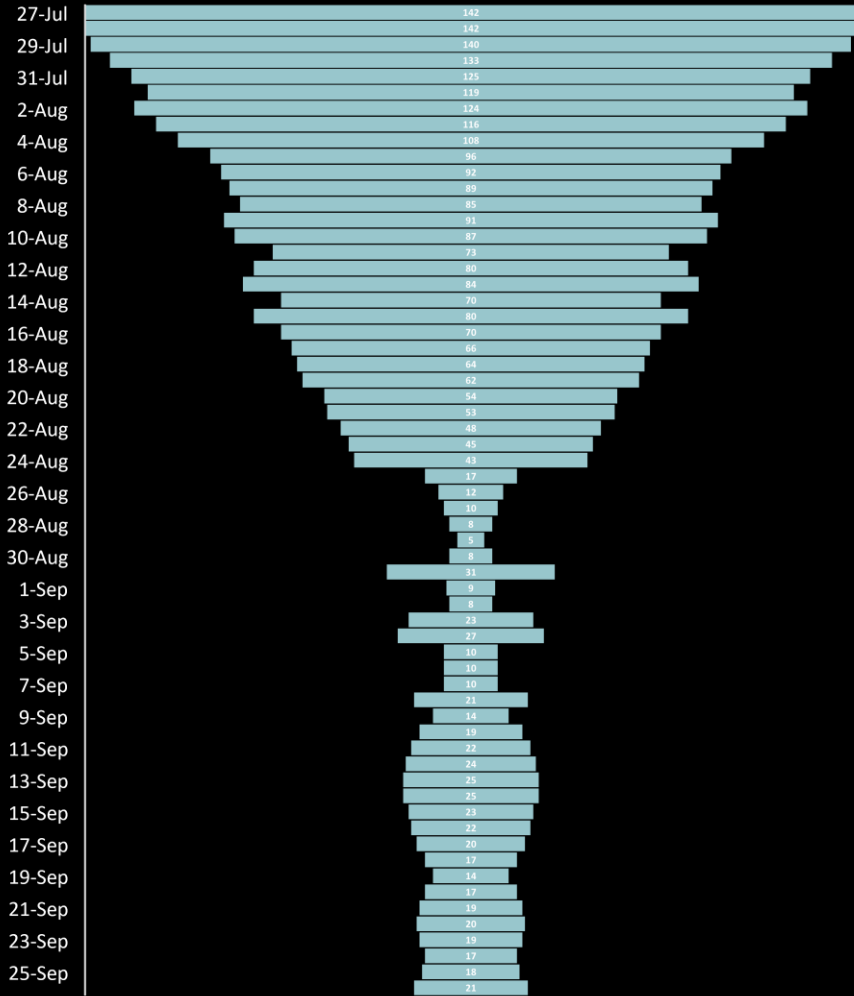
# Daily and 7-day Average Percent Positive



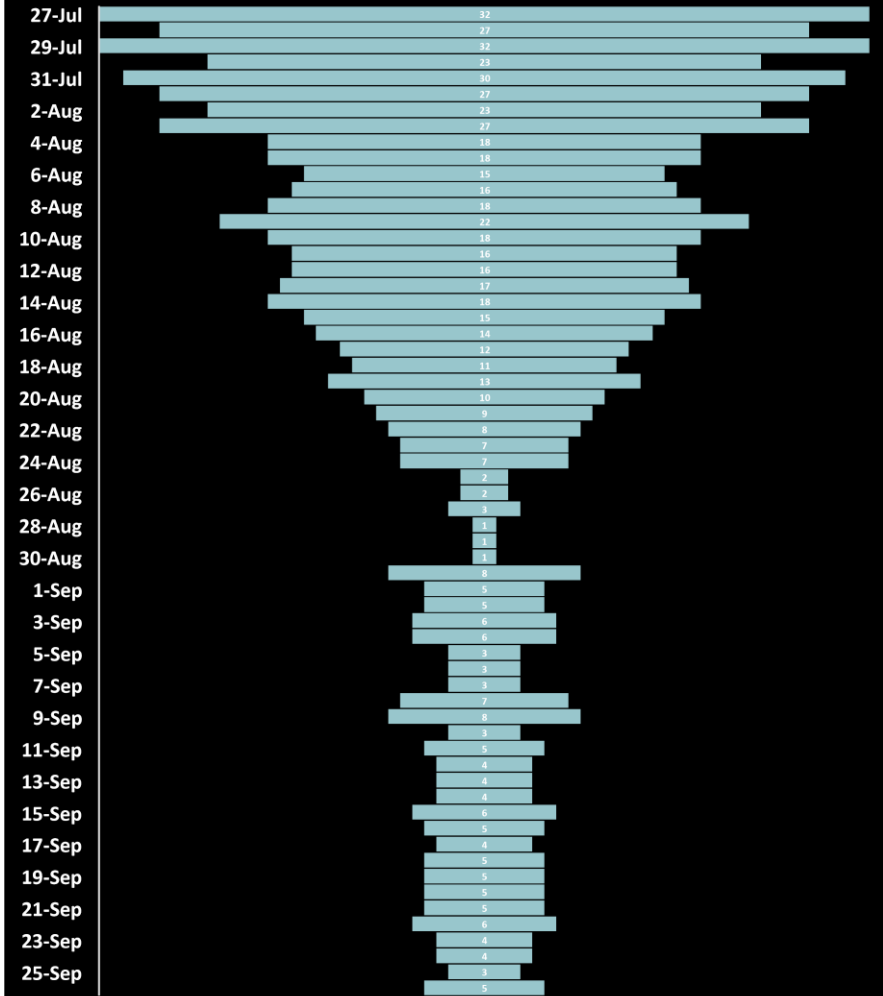


# COVID-19 Positive in Hospitals and ICU's

# Local Testing Sites

- **Manatee County Rural Health** (over 25,300 tested to date)
  - All clinics offering testing
- **FDOH Mobile Testing at:**
  - Mobile Home Parks
  - Migrant Farm Camps
- **Drive-Thru Testing at Cattleman Road**
  - 9:00AM-5:00PM daily
  - Adults and children 5+
  - Antibody testing available for persons age 18+
- **Walk-Up Operations at Lincoln Park**
  - 7:00AM-4:00PM daily
  - Adults ages and children 12+
  - Capable of performing 500 tests per day
  - Antibody testing available



# Goals

- Monitor hospital system for increases in COVID-19 prevalence
- Test 2% of our population each month
- Continue targeted messaging (#Maskupmanatee, effectiveness of masks, proper hygiene, and social distancing)
- Provide testing for underserved populations via DOH-Manatee
- Develop a plan for vaccine distribution
