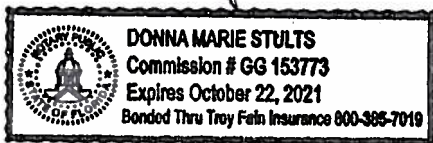

NOTICE IF HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 125.66, Florida Statutes, that the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, will conduct a public hearing on the 24th day of April 2018, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter in the Commission Chambers on the First Floor of the Manatee County Government Administrative Center, located at 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida, 34205, to consider, act upon, adopt, or reject the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 18-26

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO SECONDHAND DEALERS; AMENDING SECTIONS 2-19-104 THROUGH 2-19-106 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE; AMENDING DEFINITION FOR PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD; AMENDING TRANSACTION RECORDS TO REQUIRE A COLORED PHOTOGRAPH; PROVIDING FOR NOTIFICATION WHEN HOLDING PERIOD EXPIRES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Copies of proposed **ORDINANCE 18-26** may be inspected by the public during normal business hours in the Office of the County Attorney, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Suite 969, Bradenton, Florida. Interested parties may appear at the public hearing and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance.

According to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, if any person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter to be considered at the meeting or hearing, he/she will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose, he/she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record would include any testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
