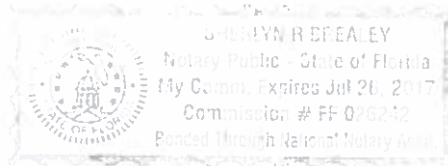

AGREEMENT CHANGES IN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County will conduct Public Hearings on Tuesday, August 8 and 22, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., at the Manatee County Government Administrative Center, 1st Floor Chambers, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida, to consider and act upon the following matter:

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO LDA-14-03(R) -
LOCAL DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT
FOR THE AVIARY AT RUTLAND RANCH -
DTS20170257**

Request: Approval of an Amendment to the Local Development Agreement dated April 21, 2015, providing for thirty six (36) months from the Effective Date for approval of a Final Site Plan for Phase 1; providing conditions for permanent reservation of wastewater line capacity for 784 dwelling units; providing for severability, and providing for an effective date. The First Amendment to Local Development Agreement (The Aviary at Rutland Ranch) applies to The Aviary at Rutland Ranch development, for which approval was granted on January 3, 2013, pursuant to an application known as PDR-12-03(Z)(G), (400.00± acres). The proposed use of the property is a single family detached, semi-detached and attached residential development. The Aviary at Rutland Ranch was approved for a maximum of 784 residential units, with a maximum height of 35 feet, and a gross density of 1.96 dwelling units per acre. The site is located in the Planned Development Residential (PDR) Zoning District and is located approximately 1800' east of 161st Avenue East, and north of C.R. 675 at 16410 C.R. 675, Parrish, Florida.
