Key Design Elements:

- Two Pool Facilities –
 - A main pool to be equipped with competitive swim lanes to accommodate high school and youth competitive swimming.
 - A support pool facility to be equipped with zero-depth, beach entry to accommodate learn to swim, drown prevention, and exercise therapy programs.
- State-of-the-art Filtration and Sanitation Systems
- Shaded Pool Decking
- Locker / Restroom Facility
- Lifeguard / First Aid Offices
- Expansion of the Existing Splash Pad Area with Larger Deck Space, Shade Structure and Additional Water Features
- Expanded Parking Availability
- Relocation of Basketball Courts to Sylvan Oaks Park

These facilities will be designed and constructed following consultation with U.S. Swimming Association.
