NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Section 125.66, Florida Statutes, that the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida will conduct a Public Hearing in the Chambers on the 1st floor of the Manatee County Administrative Center, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, Bradenton, Florida on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. to consider, act upon, adopt or reject the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE 18-14

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, REGARDING PUBLIC FINANCE; AMENDING CHAPTER 2-23 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE OF LAWS ESTABLISHING THE BRADEN RIVER PRESERVE MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT (MSTU) TO FUND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MSTU; AUTHORIZING THE ANNUAL LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES WITHIN SUCH MSTU TO PROVIDE FOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

According to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, if any person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter to be considered at the public hearing, a record of the proceedings may be required and for such purpose, you may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which would include any testimony or evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
