## PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND PUBLIC BENEFIT

Flotilla 81 provides safe boating education/training, safe boating information, and educational literature to the public; provides Safe Boating information and literature to local merchants; conducts Vessel Safety Checks; conducts training and safety patrols; conducts search and rescue missions; and provides assistance to recreational boaters on the waters of Manatee County, including but not limited to, the Manatee River, Terra Ceia Bay, Tampa Bay, and the Intercoastal Waterway.

Flotilla 81 monitors and reports to the Coast Guard the condition of Aids to Navigation (ATON) in the Manatee River, Terra Ceia Bay, Tampa Bay, and the Intercoastal Waterway.

Flotilla 81 provides Marine Safety/Environmental Protection by providing trained responders for environmental and pollution incidents.


Flotilla 81 augments the services of U.S. Coast Guard Station Cortez and Sector Saint Petersburg by providing trained personnel for food services, radio watchstanding, search and rescue (SAR) missions, regatta functions such as the Manatee River Boat Races, and marine environmental protection and maritime safety/security missions.

Flotilla 81 provides Coast Guard liaison with Manatee County Emergency Operations and provides staffing at the EOC during emergencies and exercises.

Our grant request will afford us the ability to continue to provide exceptional boating safety education to the public with the aim of reducing loss of life, personal injury and property damage to recreational boaters; and continue to deliver the highest possible quality training, resources and materials required to perform our boating safety/education & marine safety/ environmental protection missions and provide assistance to recreational boaters in Manatee County.

The U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, created by an Act of Congress in 1939, is the uniformed civilian component of the U.S. Coast Guard and supports the Coast Guard across all mission areas. Each year Auxiliarists nationwide volunteer more than four million hours benefiting boaters and their families.


