NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Section 125.66 of Florida Statutes, that the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida will conduct a public hearing in the Chambers of the Board of Manatee County Administrative Complex, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, first floor, Bradenton, Florida, during its regular meeting of May 8th, 2018, at 9:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, to consider, act upon, enact or reject the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 18-23

AN ORDINANCE OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO PRIVATE, UNATTENDED INSTALLATIONS, DISPLAYS OR EXHIBITS ON THE GROUNDS OF COUNTY PUBLIC BUILDINGS; AMENDING ARTICLE IX OF CHAPTER 2-21 OF THE MANATEE COUNTY CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Interested parties may appear and be heard at the meeting with respect to the proposed Ordinance. Pursuant to Section 286.0105 of Florida Statutes, if any person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board with respect to any matter to be considered at the meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose, she or he may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record would include any testimony or evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

The proposed Ordinance is available for public inspection at the Property Management Department of the County, 1112 Manatee Avenue West, eighth floor, Bradenton, Florida, during regular business hours. A reasonable charge may be made for the provision of copies.
