Conflict of Interest for Federal Grants

Purpose

To ensure consistent documented process for the compliance with the Federal Conflict of Interest provision in relation to the acceptance of grant funding from any source to any County Department reporting to the Board of County Commissioners.

Policy

As a part of the grant application process, the grant preparer must positively state on any grant form, when asked, that there is an absence of a financial or other interest or affiliation held by them or a member of their immediate family in the funding agency or in companies from which goods and services will be obtained under the supported activity.

Should there be a conflict of interest within the County; the applicant department shall ensure that the procedures outlined in the Manatee County Human Resources Personnel, Policy, Rules and Procedures Manual are followed.
