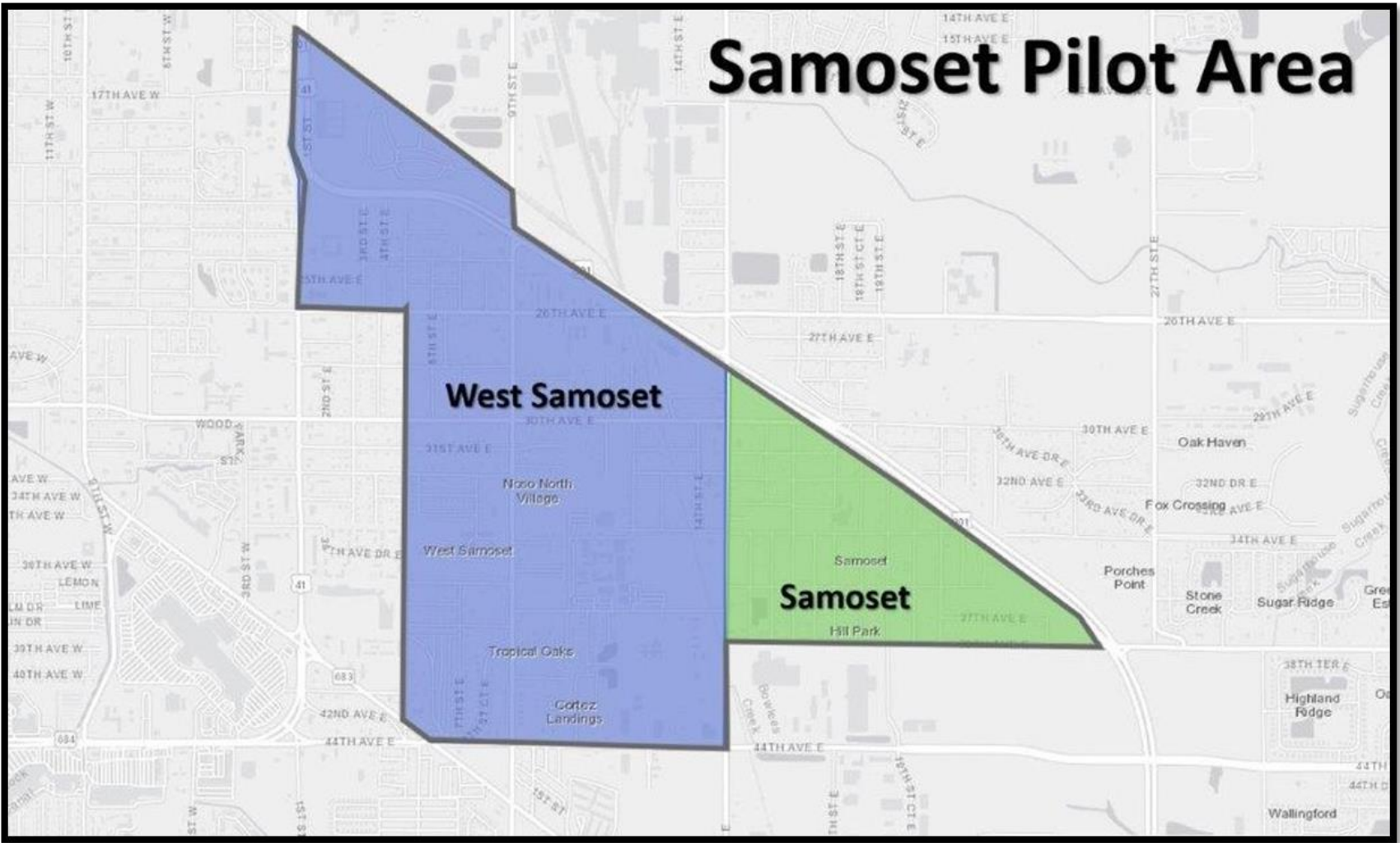

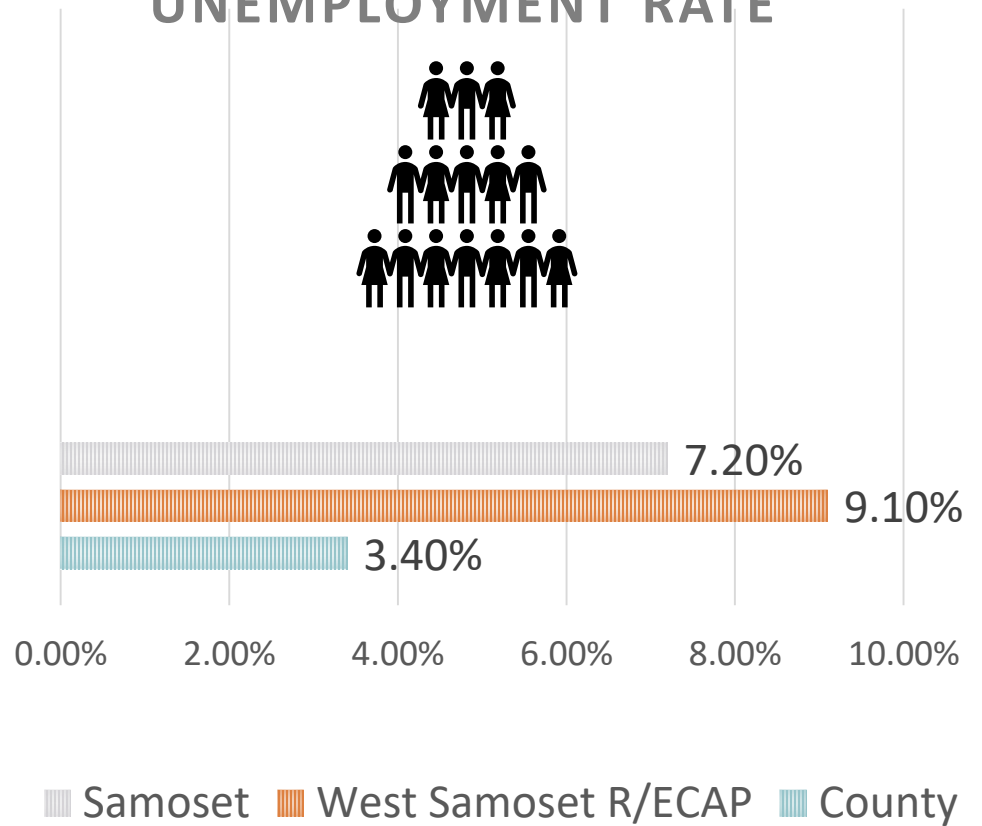

Samoset Pilot Area



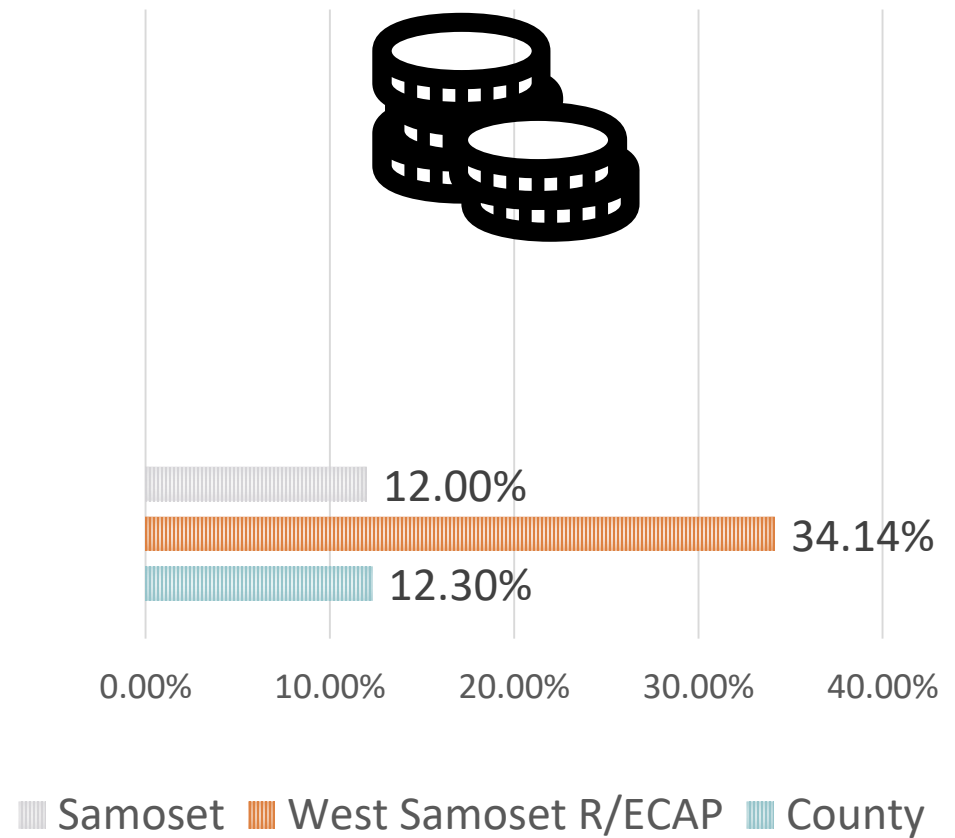
Samoset Economic Security

CURRENT UNEMPLOYMENT RATE



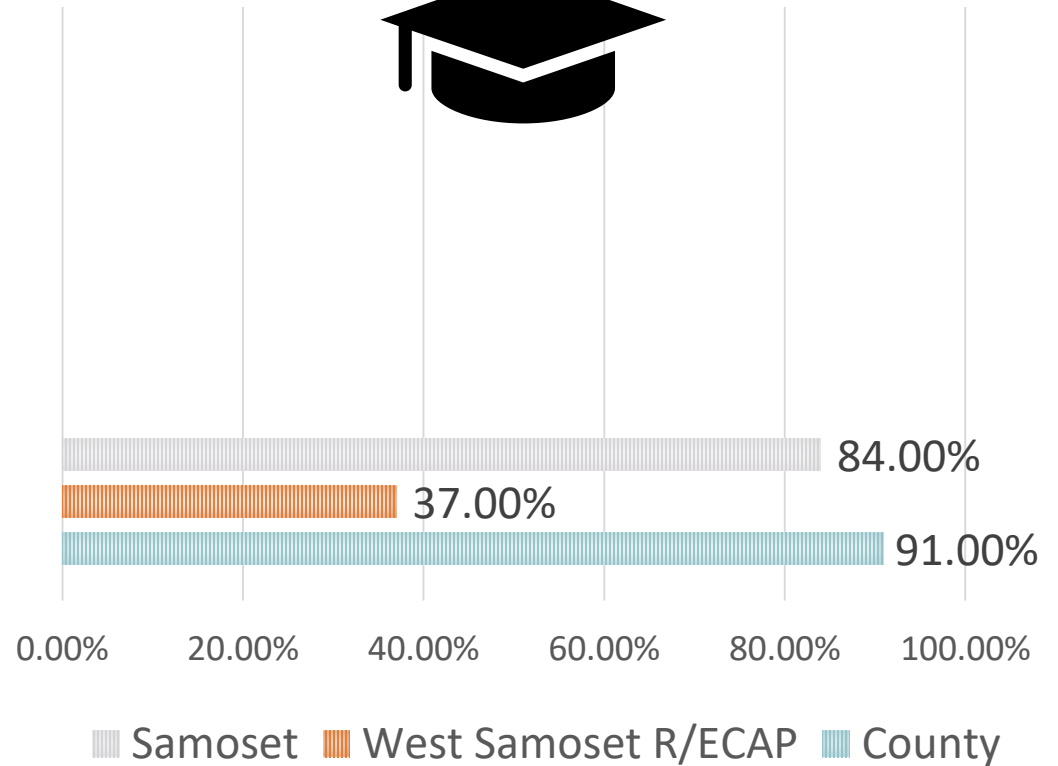
Samoset Economic Security

2018 POVERTY RATE

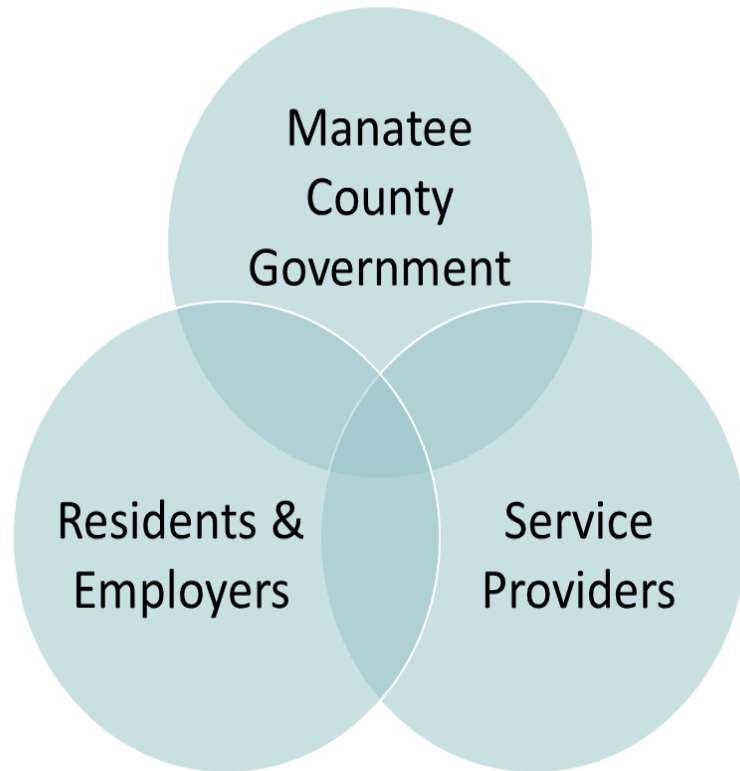
