# Camera Locations

- **2012 - Notices of Violation Started**

1. 34th Street West at 53rd Avenue West (northbound traffic)
2. 34th Street West at 53rd Avenue West (southbound traffic)
3. 15th Street East at 57th Ave. E. (northbound traffic)
4. 15th Street East at 57th Ave. E. (southbound traffic)

- **2013 - Notices of Violation Started**

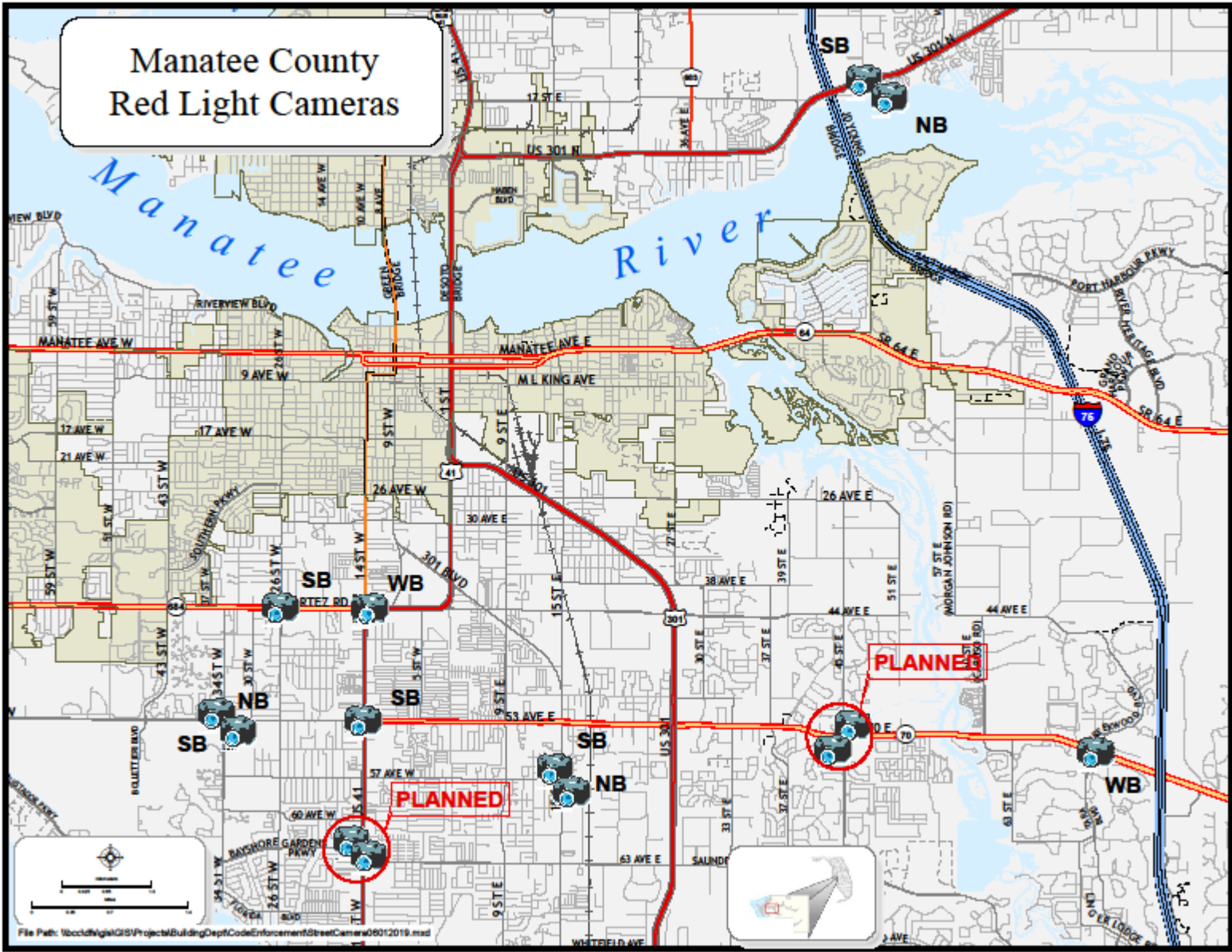
1. 60th Avenue East at U.S. Hwy 301 (southbound traffic)
2. U.S. Hwy 301 at 60th Ave. E. (northbound traffic)
3. State Road 70 at Tara Blvd. (westbound traffic)
4. 26th Street West at Cortez Road (southbound traffic)

- **2016 - Notices of Violation Started**

1. Cortez Road and U.S. 41 (14th Street West) (west bound traffic)
2. US 41 (14<sup>th</sup> Street West) and 53<sup>rd</sup> Ave East (south bound traffic)
