RECOMMENDATION:

Execution of Change Order No.1 to P.O. T1700094 with Westra Construction Corp increasing the contract amount by \$360,989.54 from \$7,378,599.83 to \$7,739,589.37, and no change to the contract time. The funding source for this contract is utility rates and Utilities 2015 Rev Rep & Imp.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN/POLICY DETERMINATION:

The services requested are consistent with Comprehensive Plan Goal 9.1 for Wastewater and the Manatee County Purchasing Ordinance.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

- March 31, 2017, the BCC executed a contract with Westra Construction Corp in the amount of \$7,427,550.03 for the replacement of aging County Force Mains and Water Mains.
- Change Order No. 1 is for \$360,989.54 and provides for final accounting of quantities, additional work required for the FDOT and the City of Bradenton Beach, and to address found underground conditions requiring work revisions.
